













Luke 23:16-Therefore I will punish Him and release Him.

Matt. 27:26-Then he released Barabbas for them; but after having Jesus scourged, he handed Him over to be crucified.

Gen. 3:18-Both thorns and thistles it shall grow for you; And you will eat the plants of the field.

Rom. 6:23-For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

John 18:22-When He had said this, one of the officers standing nearby struck Jesus, saying, “Is that the way You answer the high priest?”

Matt 26:67-68- Then they spat in His face and beat Him with their fists; and others slapped Him, <sup>68</sup>and said, “Prophecy to us, You <sup>[v]</sup>Christ; who is the one who hit You?”

Gen. 3:21-The LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife, and clothed them.

Exod. 12:5-Your lamb shall be an unblemished male a year old; you may take it from the sheep or from the goats.

John 1:29-The next day he \*saw Jesus coming to him and \*said, “Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!

John 1:36-and he looked at Jesus as He walked, and \*said, “Behold, the Lamb of God!

Rev. 19:11-16-And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it *is* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and wages war. <sup>12</sup> His eyes *are* a flame of fire, and on His head *are* many diadems; and He has a name

written *on Him* which no one knows except Himself. <sup>13</sup> *He is* clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. <sup>14</sup> And the armies which are in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white *and* clean, were following Him on white horses. <sup>15</sup> From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will <sup>[d]</sup>rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the <sup>[e]</sup>wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty. <sup>16</sup> And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written, “KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.”

Luke 23:2-And they began to accuse Him, saying, “We found this man misleading our nation and forbidding to pay taxes to Caesar, and saying that He Himself is Christ, a King.”

Matt. 27:19-While he was sitting on the judgment seat, his wife sent him *a message*, saying, “Have nothing to do with that righteous Man; for <sup>[a]</sup>last night I suffered greatly in a dream because of Him.”

## 9

John 18:38-Pilate \*said to Him, “What is truth?” And when he had said this, he went out again to the Jews and \*said to them, “I find no guilt in Him.

Rom 1:24-Therefore God gave them over in the lusts of their hearts to impurity, so that their bodies would be dishonored among them.

Jer. 7:16-As for you, do not pray for this people, and do not lift up cry or prayer for them, and do not intercede with Me; for I do not hear you

Gen. 6:3-Then the LORD said, “My Spirit shall not <sup>[a]</sup>strive with man forever, <sup>[b]</sup>because he also is flesh; <sup>[c]</sup>nevertheless his days shall be one hundred and twenty years.”

Matt. 26:62-63-The high priest stood up and said to Him, “Do You not answer? What is it that these men are testifying against You?” <sup>63</sup> But Jesus kept silent.

Isa 53:7-He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He did not open His mouth; Like a lamb that is led to slaughter, And like a sheep that is silent before its shearers, So He did not open His mouth.

Dan. 5:22-24-Yet you, his <sup>[x]</sup>son, Belshazzar, have not humbled your heart, <sup>[y]</sup>even though you knew all this, <sup>23</sup> but you have exalted yourself against the Lord of heaven; and they have brought the vessels of His house before you, and you and your nobles, your wives and your concubines have been drinking wine from them; and you have praised the gods of silver and gold, of bronze, iron, wood and stone, which do not see, hear or understand. But the God in whose hand are your life-breath and all your ways, you have not glorified. <sup>24</sup> Then the <sup>[z]</sup>hand was sent from Him and this inscription was written out.

Eph. 6:9-And masters, do the same things to them, and give up threatening, knowing that both their Master and yours is in heaven, and there is no partiality with Him

Rom. 13:1-Every <sup>[a]</sup>person is to be in subjection to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except <sup>[b]</sup>from God, and those which exist are established by God.

Gen. 9:6-Whoever sheds man's blood, By man his blood shall be shed, For in the image of God He made man.

Luke 12:48-but the one who did not know *it*, and committed deeds worthy of <sup>[a]</sup>a flogging, will receive but few. From everyone who has been given much, much will be required; and to whom they entrusted much, of him they will ask all the more.

Matt. 11:20-24-Then He began to denounce the cities in which most of His <sup>[a]</sup>miracles were done, because they did not repent. <sup>21</sup> “Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the <sup>[b]</sup>miracles had occurred in Tyre and Sidon which occurred in you, they would have repented long ago in <sup>[c]</sup>sackcloth and ashes. <sup>22</sup> Nevertheless I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon in *the* day of judgment than for you. <sup>23</sup> And you, Capernaum, will not be exalted to heaven, will you? You will descend to Hades; for if the <sup>[d]</sup>miracles had occurred in Sodom which occurred in you, it would have remained to this day. <sup>24</sup> Nevertheless I say to you that it will be more tolerable for the land of Sodom in *the* day of judgment, than for you.”

Matt. 16:1-3-The Pharisees and Sadducees came up, and testing Jesus, they asked Him to show them a <sup>[a]</sup>sign from heaven. <sup>2</sup> But He replied to them, “<sup>[b]</sup>When it is evening, you say, ‘*It will be*

fair weather, for the sky is red.’<sup>3</sup> And in the morning, ‘*There will be* a storm today, for the sky is red and threatening.’ Do you know how to discern the <sup>[c]</sup>appearance of the sky, but cannot *discern* the signs of the times?

Heb. 13:20-21-Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep <sup>[a]</sup>through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord,<sup>21</sup> equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
