# <u>27</u>

Constable-"Even as He hung dying an excruciatingly painful death, Jesus compassionately made provision for His mother."

Exod 20:12-Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be prolonged in the land which the LORD your God gives you

Mark 7:6-13-And He said to them, "Rightly did Isaiah prophesy of you hypocrites, as it is written: 'THIS PEOPLE HONORS ME WITH THEIR LIPS, BUT THEIR HEART IS FAR AWAY FROM ME.7 'BUT IN VAIN DO THEY WORSHIP ME, TEACHING AS DOCTRINES THE PRECEPTS OF MEN.'8 Neglecting the commandment of God, you hold to the tradition of men." He was also saying to them, "You are experts at setting aside the commandment of God in order to keep your tradition. <sup>10</sup> For Moses said, 'HONOR YOUR FATHER AND YOUR MOTHER'; and, 'HE WHO SPEAKS EVIL OF FATHER OR MOTHER, IS TO [a] BE PUT TO DEATH'; 11 but you say, 'If a man says to his father or his mother, whatever I have that would help you is Corban (that is to say, [b] given to God), '12 you no longer permit him to do anything for his father or his mother; 13 thus invalidating the word of God by your tradition which you have handed down; and you do many things such as that."

1 Tim. 5:3-4-Honor widows who are widows indeed; <sup>4</sup> but if any widow has children or grandchildren, they must first learn to practice piety in regard to their own family and to <sup>[a]</sup>make some return to their parents; for this is acceptable in the sight of God.

Luke 1:46-47-And Mary said: "My soul [a] exalts the Lord, 47 And my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior.

Matt. 13:55-Is not this the carpenter's son? Is not His mother called Mary, and His brothers, James and Joseph and Simon and Judas?

1 Tim. 2:5-For there is one God, *and* one mediator also between God and men, *the* man Christ Jesus

John 14:6-Jesus \*said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me

# <u>28</u>

Matt. 27:45-Now from the <sup>[a]</sup>sixth hour darkness <sup>[b]</sup>fell upon all the land until the <sup>[c]</sup>ninth hour.

Matt. 27:46-47-About the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "ELI, ELI, LAMA SABACHTHANI?" that is, "MY GOD, MY GOD, WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN ME?" <sup>47</sup> And some of those who were standing there, when they heard it, *began* saying, "This man is calling for Elijah."

John 10:30-I and the Father are [a] one.

John 12:23- And Jesus \*answered them, saying, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified.

John 17:1-Jesus spoke these things; and lifting up His eyes to heaven, He said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify Your Son, that the Son may glorify You,

John 17:4-I glorified You on the earth, <sup>[b]</sup>having accomplished the work which You have given Me to do

Jude 14-*It was* also about these men *that* Enoch, *in* the seventh *generation* from Adam, prophesied, saying, "Behold, the Lord came with [a] many thousands of His holy ones

Rom. 8:30-and these whom He predestined, He also called; and these whom He called, He also justified; and these whom He justified, He also glorified.

John 4:6-and Jacob's well was there. So Jesus, being wearied from His journey, was sitting thus by the well. It was about <sup>[a]</sup>the sixth hour.

John 11:35-Jesus wept

John 11:38-So Jesus, again being deeply moved within, came to the tomb. Now it was a cave, and a stone was lying against it.

Matt. 4:3-And the tempter came and said to Him, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread."

John 1:48-Nathanael \*said to Him, "How do You know me?" Jesus answered and said to him, "Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you."

John 4:14-but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him shall never thirst; but the water that I will give him will become in him a well of water springing up to eternal life

John 7:38-He who believes in Me, as the Scripture said, 'From <sup>[i]</sup>his innermost being will flow rivers of living water.'"

Rev. 22:17- The Spirit and the bride say, "Come." And let the one who hears say, "Come." And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who wishes take the water of life without cost.

Ps. 22:15-My strength is dried up like a potsherd, And my tongue cleaves to my jaws; And You lay me in the dust of death.

# <u>29</u>

Ps. 69:21-They also gave me gall <sup>[b]</sup> for my food And for my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink.

Exod. 12:22-You shall take a bunch of hyssop and dip it in the blood which is in the basin, and <sup>[a]</sup>apply some of the blood that is in the basin to the lintel and the two doorposts; and none of you shall go outside the door of his house until morning.

Exod 12:5-Your [i]lamb shall be an unblemished male a year old; you may take it from the sheep or from the goats.

Exod 12:46-It is to be eaten in a single house; you are not to bring forth any of the flesh outside of the house, nor are you to break any bone of it.

# <u>30</u>

Blum (BKC)- "Papyri receipts for taxes have been recovered with the word *tetelestai* written across them, meaning 'paid in full.'"

Isa. 64:6-For all of us have become like one who is unclean, And all our righteous deeds are like a filthy garment; And all of us wither like a leaf, And our iniquities, like the wind, take us away.

Rom. 4:4-5-Now to the one who works, his wage is not credited as a favor, but as what is due. <sup>5</sup> But to the one who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is credited as righteousness.

Matt. 27:50-And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice, and yielded up His spirit.

Acts 7:59-They went on stoning Stephen as he called on *the Lord* and said, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit!"

John 10:18-No one has taken it away from Me, but I lay it down on My own initiative. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. This commandment I received from My Father.

Heb. 13:20-21-Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep <sup>[a]</sup>through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, <sup>21</sup> equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever.
