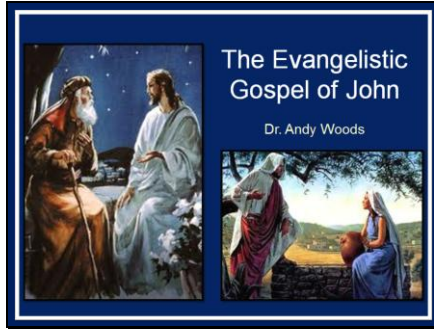


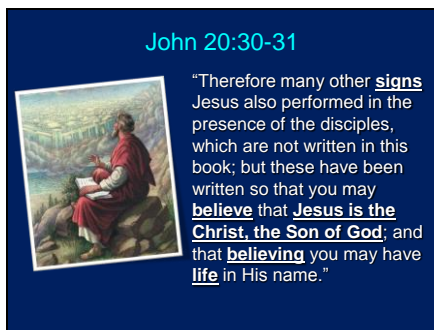

Constable-"Even as He hung dying an excruciatingly painful death, Jesus compassionately made provision for His mother."

Exod 20:12-Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be prolonged in the land which the LORD your God gives you

Mark 7:6-13-And He said to them, "Rightly did Isaiah prophesy of you hypocrites, as it is written: 'THIS PEOPLE HONORS ME WITH THEIR LIPS, BUT THEIR HEART IS FAR AWAY FROM ME.'⁷ 'BUT IN VAIN DO THEY WORSHIP ME, TEACHING AS DOCTRINES THE PRECEPTS OF MEN.'⁸ Neglecting the commandment of God, you hold to the tradition of men."⁹ He was also saying to them, "You are experts at setting aside the commandment of God in order to keep your tradition."¹⁰ For Moses said, 'HONOR YOUR FATHER AND YOUR MOTHER'; and, 'HE WHO SPEAKS EVIL OF FATHER OR MOTHER, IS TO ^[a]BE PUT TO DEATH';¹¹ but you say, 'If a man says to *his* father or *his* mother, whatever I have that would help you is Corban (that is to say, ^[b]given to God),'¹² you no longer permit him to do anything for *his* father or *his* mother;¹³ *thus* invalidating the word of God by your tradition which you have handed down; and you do many things such as that."

1 Tim. 5:3-4-Honor widows who are widows indeed; ⁴ but if any widow has children or grandchildren, they must first learn to practice piety in regard to their own family and to ^[a]make some return to their parents; for this is acceptable in the sight of God.

Luke 1:46-47-And Mary said: “My soul ^[a]exalts the Lord,⁴⁷ And my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior.

Matt. 13:55-Is not this the carpenter’s son? Is not His mother called Mary, and His brothers, James and Joseph and Simon and Judas?

1 Tim. 2:5-For there is one God, *and* one mediator also between God and men, *the* man Christ Jesus

John 14:6-Jesus *said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me

Matt. 27:45-Now from the ^[a]sixth hour darkness ^[b]fell upon all the land until the ^[c]ninth hour.

Matt. 27:46-47-About the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, “ELI, ELI, LAMA SABACHTHANI?” that is, “MY GOD, MY GOD, WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN ME?” ⁴⁷ And some of those who were standing there, when they heard it, *began* saying, “This man is calling for Elijah.”

John 10:30-I and the Father are ^[a]one.

John 12:23- And Jesus *answered them, saying, “The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified.

John 17:1-Jesus spoke these things; and lifting up His eyes to heaven, He said, “Father, the hour has come; glorify Your Son, that the Son may glorify You,

John 17:4-I glorified You on the earth, ^[b]having accomplished the work which You have given Me to do

Jude 14-*It was also about these men that Enoch, in the seventh generation from Adam, prophesied, saying, “Behold, the Lord came with ^[a]many thousands of His holy ones*

Rom. 8:30-and these whom He predestined, He also called; and these whom He called, He also justified; and these whom He justified, He also glorified.

John 4:6-and Jacob’s well was there. So Jesus, being wearied from His journey, was sitting thus by the well. It was about ^[a]the sixth hour.

Blum (BKC)- "Papyri receipts for taxes have been recovered with the word *tetelestai* written across them, meaning 'paid in full.'"

Isa. 64:6-For all of us have become like one who is unclean,
And all our righteous deeds are like a filthy garment; And all of
us wither like a leaf, And our iniquities, like the wind, take us
away.

Rom. 4:4-5-Now to the one who works, his wage is not credited
as a favor, but as what is due. ⁵ But to the one who does not
work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is
credited as righteousness.

Matt. 27:50-And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice, and
yielded up His spirit.

Acts 7:59-They went on stoning Stephen as he called on *the*

John 10:18-No one has taken it away from Me, but I lay it down
