John 1:47-48- Jesus saw Nathanael coming to Him, and \*said of him, “Behold, an Israelite indeed, in whom there is no deceit!”

<sup>48</sup> Nathanael \*said to Him, “How do You know me?” Jesus answered and said to him, “**Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you.**”

Philip. 2:5-8- Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, <sup>7</sup> but **emptied Himself**, taking the form of a bond-servant, *and* being made in the likeness of men. <sup>8</sup> Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death <sup>[h]</sup> on a cross.

John 1:14- And **the Word became flesh**, and <sup>[k]</sup> dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of <sup>[l]</sup> the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

1 Tim. 2:4-who desires **all men** to be saved and to come to the <sup>[a]</sup> knowledge of the truth

2 Peter 3:9-The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for **all** to come to repentance

Acts 16:30-31-and after he brought them out, he said, “**Sirs**, what must I do to be saved?”<sup>31</sup> They said, “Believe in the **Lord** Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household.”

Barger-"Isa" in no way represents the Jesus of the Bible but is instead the false Jesus of the Qur'an (Koran) and the Muslim Hadith. "Isa" (pronounced "eee-sa") is the Islamic Jesus who was but a prophet and who certainly did not experience a sacrificial death on a cross let alone resurrect from the dead. In fact, in Islam the prophet Isa is actually the destroyer of Christianity - not it's Savior. Obviously, this is simply NOT the same Jesus as is Yeshua

Lev. 24:16- Moreover, the one who blasphemes the name of the LORD shall surely be put to death; all the congregation shall certainly **stone him**. The alien as well as the native, when he blasphemes the Name, shall be put to death.

John 10:30-33- **I and the Father are <sup>[a]</sup>one.**<sup>31</sup> **The Jews picked up stones again to stone Him.**<sup>32</sup> Jesus answered them, “I showed you many good works from the Father; for which of them are you **stoning Me?**”<sup>33</sup> The Jews answered Him, “**For a good work we do not stone You, but for blasphemy; and because You, being a man, make Yourself out to be God.**”

John 8:58-59- Jesus said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham <sup>[q]</sup>was born, **I am.**”<sup>59</sup> Therefore they picked up **stones** to throw at Him, but Jesus <sup>[r]</sup>hid Himself and went out of the temple.

John 1:40-42- One of the two who heard John *speak* and followed Him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. <sup>41</sup> He \*found first his own brother Simon and \*said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which translated means <sup>[ab]</sup>Christ). <sup>42</sup> He brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, "You are Simon the son of <sup>[ac]</sup>John; you shall be called Cephass" (which is translated <sup>[ad]</sup>Peter).

Matt. 4:18-22- Now as Jesus was walking by the Sea of Galilee, He saw two brothers, Simon who was called **Peter**, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen. <sup>19</sup> And He \*said to them, "<sup>[h]</sup>**Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men.**" <sup>20</sup> **Immediately they left their nets and followed Him.** <sup>21</sup> Going on from there He saw two other brothers, <sup>[i]</sup>James the *son* of Zebedee, and <sup>[j]</sup>John his brother, in the boat with Zebedee their father, mending their nets; and He called them. <sup>22</sup> Immediately they left the boat and their father, and followed Him.

John 1:34-I myself have seen, and have testified that this is the **Son of God**

John 1:49- Nathanael answered Him, "Rabbi, You are the **Son of God**; You are the King of Israel."

John 5:25-Truly, truly, I say to you, an hour is coming and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the **Son of God**, and those who hear will live

John 10:36- do you say of Him, whom the Father sanctified and sent into the world, 'You are blaspheming,' because I said, 'I am the **Son of God**'?

John 6:69-We have believed and have come to know that You are the **Holy One of God**.

John 9:35-Jesus heard that they had put him out, and finding him, He said, “Do you believe in the **Son of Man**?”

John 11:27-She \*said to Him, “Yes, Lord; I have believed that You are <sup>[a]</sup>the Christ, the **Son of God**, *even* <sup>[b]</sup>He who comes into the world.”

John 20:30-31- Therefore many other <sup>[a]</sup>signs Jesus also performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book;<sup>31</sup> but these have been written so that you may believe that Jesus is <sup>[b]</sup>the Christ, the **Son of God**; and that believing you may have life in His name.

John 8:58-Jesus said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham <sup>[a]</sup>was born, **I am**.”

John 8:46-**Which one of you convicts Me of sin?** If I speak truth, why do you not believe Me?

John 11:11-14-This He said, and after that He \*said to them, “Our friend Lazarus has fallen asleep; but I go, so that I may awaken him out of sleep.”<sup>12</sup> The disciples then said to Him, “Lord, if he has fallen asleep, he will <sup>[a]</sup>recover.”<sup>13</sup> Now Jesus had spoken of his death, but they thought that He was speaking of <sup>[b]</sup>literal sleep.<sup>14</sup> So Jesus then said to them plainly, “**Lazarus is dead**,

John 5:28-30-Do not marvel at this; for an hour is coming, in which all who are in the tombs will hear His voice,<sup>29</sup> and will come forth; those who did the good *deeds* to a resurrection of

life, those who committed the evil *deeds* to a resurrection of judgment.<sup>30</sup> “I can do nothing on My own initiative. As I hear, I judge; and **My judgment is just**, because I do not seek My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

John 11:43- When He had said these things, He cried out with a loud voice, “**Lazarus, come forth.**”

John 5:22-For not even the Father judges anyone, but He has **given all judgment to the Son**

John 5:27-and He **gave Him authority to execute judgment**, because He is <sup>[f]</sup>the Son of Man

John 3:16- For God so loved the **world**, that He gave His <sup>[e]</sup>only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

John 20:16- Jesus \*said to her, “**Mary!**” She turned and \*said to Him in <sup>[a]</sup>Hebrew, “Rabboni!” (which means, Teacher).

John 10:4-When he puts forth all his own, he goes ahead of them, and the sheep follow him because **they know his voice.**

John 13:17- If you know these things, you are blessed if you do them.

John 20:8-So the other disciple who had first come to the tomb then also entered, and he saw and **believed**

1 Pet. 1:8-9- and though **you have not seen Him**, you love Him, and though you do not see Him now, but believe in Him, you

greatly rejoice with joy inexpressible and <sup>[f]</sup>full of glory,  
<sup>9</sup> obtaining as the outcome of your faith the salvation of <sup>[g]</sup>your  
souls.

Heb. 11:1- Now **faith** is the <sup>[a]</sup>assurance of *things* <sup>[b]</sup>**hoped** for,  
the <sup>[c]</sup>**conviction of things not seen.**

Heb. 11:6- And **without faith it is impossible to please Him,**  
for he who comes to God must **believe** that He is and *that* He is  
a rewarder of those who seek Him.

John 16:7-11- But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that  
I go away; for if I do not go away, the <sup>[a]</sup>Helper will not come to  
you; but if I go, I will send Him to you. <sup>8</sup> And He, when He  
comes, will **convict the world concerning sin** and  
righteousness and judgment. **Concerning sin, because they do  
not believe in Me;** <sup>10</sup> and concerning righteousness, because I go  
to the Father and you no longer see Me; <sup>11</sup> and concerning  
judgment, because the ruler of this world has been judged.

Heb. 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the  
dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the  
eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, <sup>21</sup> equip you in every  
good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in  
His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever  
and ever. Amen.
