































## 20

John 19:34- But one of the soldiers **pierced** His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out.

Luke 24:39- See My hands and **My feet**, that it is I Myself; touch Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have.

Luke 24:37- But they were **startled and frightened** and thought that they were seeing a spirit.

Rev. 5:6- And **I saw** between the throne (with the four living creatures) and the elders a **Lamb standing, as if slain**, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God, sent out into all the earth.

## 21

John 17:18-As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world.

Acts 1:21-22- Therefore it is necessary that of the men who have accompanied us all the time that the Lord Jesus went in and out <sup>[t]</sup>among us—<sup>22</sup> beginning with the baptism of John until the day that He was taken up from us—one of these *must* become a witness with us of His resurrection.

Acts 14:4- But the people of the city were divided; and some sided with the Jews, and some with the **apostles**

Acts 14:14- But when the **apostles** Barnabas and Paul heard of it, they tore their robes and rushed out into the crowd, crying out.

2 Cor. 8:23- As for Titus, *he is* my partner and fellow worker among you; as for our brethren, *they are* **messengers** of the churches, a glory to Christ.

Philip. 2:25- But I thought it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, my brother and fellow worker and fellow soldier, who is also your **messenger** and minister to my need.

Matt. 10:1-2-Jesus summoned His twelve **disciples** and gave them authority over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal every kind of disease and every kind of sickness. Now the names of the twelve **apostles** are these: The first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; and James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother.

Matthew 28:19-20- Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.

Mark 16:15-16- And He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation. <sup>16</sup>He who has believed and has been baptized shall be saved; but he who has disbelieved shall be condemned.

Luke 24:46-48- and He said to them, “Thus it is written, that the Christ would suffer and rise again from the dead the third day, <sup>47</sup> and that repentance for forgiveness of sins would be proclaimed in His name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. <sup>48</sup> You are witnesses of these things.

Acts 1:8- but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth.

Ephesians 3:21- to Him *be* the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen.

Ephesians 4:11-16-And He gave some *as* apostles, and some *as* prophets, and some *as* evangelists, and some *as* pastors and teachers,<sup>12</sup> for the equipping of the <sup>[d]</sup>saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ; <sup>13</sup> until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the <sup>[e]</sup>knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature <sup>[f]</sup>which belongs to the fullness of Christ. <sup>14</sup> <sup>[g]</sup>As a result, we are no longer to be children, tossed here and there by waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, by craftiness <sup>[h]</sup>in deceitful scheming; <sup>15</sup> but <sup>[i]</sup>speaking the truth in love, <sup>[j]</sup>we are to grow up in all *aspects* into Him who is the head, *even* Christ, <sup>16</sup> from whom the whole body, being fitted and held together <sup>[k]</sup>by what every joint supplies, according to the <sup>[l]</sup>proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love.

Acts 1:6-7- So when they had come together, they were asking Him, saying, “Lord, is it at this time You are restoring the kingdom to Israel?”<sup>7</sup> He said to them, “It is not for you to know times or epochs which the Father has fixed by His own authority.

Acts 1:8- but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth.

Rev. 11:15-Then the seventh angel sounded; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, “The kingdom of the world has become *the kingdom* of our Lord and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever.”

Ryrie- Ryrie explains how such priorities can easily get out of order. “Holistic redemption can easily lead to placing unbalanced, if not wrong, priorities on political action, social agendas, and improving the structures of society.” Ryrie, *Dispensationalism*, 176.

Rom 1:16-For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

John 3:16- For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

John 15:19- If you were of the world, the world would love its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, because of this the world hates you.

Luke 24:49- And behold, I am sending forth the promise of My Father upon you; but you are to stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high.

John 14:16-I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever.

John 16:12-13-I have many more things to say to you, but you cannot bear *them* now. <sup>13</sup> But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come.

Acts 1:5- for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.

Acts 2:4- And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit was giving them <sup>[f]</sup>utterance.

John 21:3- Simon Peter said to them, “I am going fishing.” They \*said to him, “We will also come with you.” They went out and got into the boat; and that night they caught nothing.

Acts 1:6-7- So when they had come together, they were asking Him, saying, “Lord, is it at this time You are restoring the kingdom to Israel?”

<sup>7</sup> He said to them, “It is not for you to know times or epochs which the Father has fixed by His own authority.

Jude 14- *It was also about these men that Enoch, in the seventh generation from Adam, prophesied, saying, “Behold, the Lord came with many thousands of His holy ones.*

Mark 2:7- Why does this man speak that way? He is blaspheming; **who can forgive sins but God alone?**

Matthew 9:2-3- And they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed. Seeing their faith, **Jesus** said to the paralytic, “Take courage, son; **your sins are forgiven.**”<sup>3</sup> And some of the **scribes** said to themselves, “**This fellow blasphemes.**”

Mark 2:7- Why does this man speak that way? He is blaspheming; **who can forgive sins but God alone?**

Luke 5:21- The scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, “Who is this *man* who speaks blasphemies? **Who can forgive sins, but God alone?**”

John 9:39, 41-And Jesus said, “For judgment I came into this world, so that those who **do not see may see**, and that those **who see may become blind.**”<sup>40</sup> Those of the Pharisees who were with Him heard these things and said to Him, “We are not blind too, are we?”<sup>41</sup> Jesus said to them, “If you were blind, you would have no sin; **but since you say, ‘We see,’ your sin remains.**”

Heb. 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord,<sup>21</sup> equip you in every good thing to do

His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
