3. What does not deter terrorism?

Eccles 8:11-Because the sentence against an evil deed is not executed quickly, therefore the hearts of the sons of men among them are given fully to do evil.

4. What effectively deters terrorism?

Rom. 13:3-4- For rulers are not a cause of fear for good behavior, but for evil. Do you want to have no fear of authority? Do what is good and you will have praise from the same; ⁴ for it is a minister of God to you for good. But if you do what is evil, be afraid; for it does not bear the sword for nothing; for it is a minister of God, an avenger who brings wrath on the one who practices evil.

1 Pet. 2:13-14-Submit yourselves for the Lord's sake to every human institution, whether to a king as the one in authority, ¹⁴ or to governors as sent by him for the punishment of evildoers and the praise of those who do right.

Deut 13:10-11-So you shall stone him to death because he has sought to seduce you from the LORD your God who brought you

out from the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery. ¹¹ Then all Israel will hear and be afraid, and will never again do such a wicked thing among you.

6. What legitimate methods can the government employ in deterring terrorism?

Obadiah 11-On the day that you stood aloof, On the day that strangers carried off his wealth, And foreigners entered his gate And cast lots for Jerusalem—You too were as one of them.

Josh. 2:1-Then Joshua the son of Nun sent two men as **spies** secretly...saying, “Go, view the land, especially Jericho.” So they went and came into the house of a harlot whose name was Rahab, and lodged there.

Prov. 13:24-He who withholds his rod hates his son, But he who loves him disciplines him diligently.
