Mosaic Covenant of Exodus 19–24




- Sinai Revelation (Gen. 15:13-16; Ps. 147:19-20)
- Limited restoration of Theocratic Administrator (Exod. 19:6; Rom. 5:13-14)
- Conditional covenant (Exod. 19:6)
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- Mosaic Covenant points to Christ (Deut. 17:15; John 5:47-49)
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
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


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Exodus 19:5-6 "Now then, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be My own possession among all the peoples, for all the earth is Mine; and you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' These are the words that you shall speak to the sons of Israel."





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Evidence of Abrahamic Covenant's Unconditional Nature

- ANE covenant ratification ceremony (Gen 15)
- Lack of stated conditions for Israel's obedience (Gen 15)
- Covenant's eternality (Gen 17:7, 13, 19; Ps. 90:2)
- Covenant's immutability (Heb 6:13-18; Mal. 3:6)
- Trans-generational reaffirmation despite perpetual national disobedience (Jer 31:35-37)

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
Hosea 4:1-2 (NASB)

They employ violence, so that bloodshed follows bloodshed."
