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When is the Rapture? Seven Arguments Favoring the Pre-Tribulation View

- Tribulation's purpose concerns Israel (Jer 30:7; Dan 9:24)
- No biblical reference to the church on earth during the Tribulation period (Rev 4-22)
- III. Church is promised an exemption from divine wrath (1 Thess 1:10; 5:9; Rom 5:9; Rev 3:10; 6:17)
- iv. Rapture is imminent (1 Cor 15:51; 1 Thess 4:15)
- v. Rapture is a comfort (1 Thess 4:18)
- vi. Antichrist cannot come to power until the restrainer is removed (2 Thess 2:6-7)
- VII. Symbolic parallels (2 Peter 2:5-9)

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



Rev. 7:9-After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could count, from every nation and *all* tribes and peoples and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, and palm branches *were* in their hands...¹³ Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, "These who are clothed in the white robes, who are they, and where have they come from?" ¹⁴ I [a] said to him, "My lord, you know." And he said to me, "These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

<u>23</u>

Dan. 2:40-43-Then there will be a fourth kingdom as strong as iron; inasmuch as iron crushes and shatters all things, so, like iron that breaks in pieces, it will crush and break all these in pieces. ⁴¹ In that you saw the feet and toes, partly of potter's clay and partly of iron, it will be a divided kingdom; but it will have in it the toughness of iron, inasmuch as you saw the iron mixed with ^[as]common clay. ⁴² As the toes of the feet *were* partly of iron and partly of pottery, *so* some of the kingdom will be strong and part of it will be brittle. ⁴³ And in that you saw the iron mixed with ^[at]common clay, they will combine with one another ^[au]in the seed of men; but they will not adhere to one another, even as iron does not combine with pottery.

Rev. 13:5-6-There was given to him a mouth speaking arrogant words and blasphemies, and authority to act for forty-two months was given to him. And he opened his mouth in blasphemies against God, to blaspheme His name and His tabernacle, *that is*, those who dwell in heaven.

Matt. 24:15-22- Therefore when you see the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION which was spoken of through Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place (let the reader understand), ¹⁶ then those who are in Judea must flee to the mountains. ¹⁷ [h] Whoever is on the housetop must not go down to get the things out that are in his house. ¹⁸ [i] Whoever is in the field must not turn back to get his cloak. ¹⁹ But woe to those who are pregnant and to

those who are nursing babies in those days! ²⁰ But pray that your flight will not be in the winter, or on a Sabbath. ²¹ For then there will be a great tribulation, such as has not occurred since the beginning of the world until now, nor ever will. ²² Unless those days had been cut short, no ^[i]life would have been saved; but for the sake of the ^[k]elect those days will be cut short.

Rev. 12:6-17- Then the woman fled into the wilderness where she had a place prepared by God, so that there she would be nourished for one thousand two hundred and sixty days.⁷ And there was war in heaven, Michael and his angels waging war with the dragon. The dragon and his angels waged war, ⁸ and they were not strong enough, and there was no longer a place found for them in heaven. ⁹ And the great dragon was thrown down, the serpent of old who is called the devil and Satan, who deceives the whole ^[d]world; he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him. ¹⁰ Then I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying, "Now the salvation, and the power, and the kingdom of our God and the authority of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren has been thrown down, he who accuses them before our God day and night. 11 And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, and they did not love their life even [e] when faced with death. 12 For this reason, rejoice, O heavens and you who [f]dwell in them. Woe to the earth and the sea, because the devil has come down to you, having great wrath, knowing that he has only a short time."13 And when the dragon saw that he was thrown down to the earth, he persecuted the woman who gave birth to the male child. ¹⁴ But the two wings of the great eagle were given to the woman, so that she could fly into the wilderness to her place,

where she *was nourished for a time and times and half a time, from the ^[g]presence of the serpent. ¹⁵ And the serpent ^[h]poured water like a river out of his mouth after the woman, so that he might cause her to be swept away with the flood. ¹⁶ ^[i]But the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened its mouth and drank up the river which the dragon ^[j]poured out of his mouth. ¹⁷ So the dragon was enraged with the woman, and went off to make war with the rest of her ^[k]children, who keep the commandments of God and hold to the testimony of Jesus.

2 Thess. 2:8- Then that lawless one will be revealed whom the Lord will slay with the breath of His mouth and bring to an end by the appearance of His ^[f]coming.

Rev. 19:20- And the beast was seized, and with him the false prophet who performed the signs ^[h]in his presence, by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image; these two were thrown alive into the lake of fire which burns with ^[i]brimstone.

Rev. 20:10-And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and ^[f]brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are also; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

families of the earth does not go up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, there will be no rain on them. ¹⁸ If the family of Egypt does not go up or enter, then no *rain will fall* on them; it will be the plague with which the LORD smites the nations who do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Booths. ¹⁹ This will be the ^[h]punishment of Egypt, and the ^[i]punishment of all the nations who do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Booths.

Dan. 8:27- Then I, Daniel, was [ai] exhausted and sick for days. Then I got up *again* and carried on the king's business; but I was astounded at the vision, and there was none to [ai] explain *it*.
