Eph. 3:3-6, 9- that by revelation there was made known to me the mystery, as I wrote before in brief. ⁴ [a]By referring to this, when you read you can understand my insight ^[b] into the mystery of Christ, ⁵ which in other generations was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed to His holy apostles and prophets ^[c] in the Spirit; ⁶ to be specific, that the Gentiles are fellow heirs and fellow members of the body, and fellow partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel,... ⁹ and to ^[e] bring to light what is the administration of the mystery which for ages has been hidden in God who created all things.

Matt. 16:18- I also say to you that you are ^[l]Peter, and upon this ^[m]rock I will build My church; and the gates of Hades will not overpower it.

Ps. 149:1- Praise ye the LORD. Sing unto the LORD a new song, and his praise in the congregation of saints (KJV)

Rom. 1:7- o all who are beloved of God in Rome, called *as* [f] saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Matt. 24:14- This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in the whole ^[g]world as a testimony to all the nations, and then the end will come.

Matt. 24:20-But pray that your flight will not be in the winter, or on a Sabbath

Matt. 24:22-Unless those days had been cut short, no ^[i]life would have been saved; but for the sake of the ^[k]elect those days will be cut short.

Rev. 7:9-_After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could count, from every nation and *all* tribes and peoples and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, and palm branches *were* in their hands...¹³ Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, "These who are clothed in the white robes, who are they, and where have they come from?" ¹⁴ I [a] said to him, "My lord, you know." And he said to me, "These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

Dan. 2:40-43-Then there will be a fourth kingdom as strong as iron; inasmuch as iron crushes and shatters all things, so, like iron that breaks in pieces, it will crush and break all these in pieces. ⁴¹ In that you saw the feet and toes, partly of potter's clay and partly of iron, it will be a divided kingdom; but it will have in it the toughness of iron, inasmuch as you saw the iron mixed with ^[as]common clay. ⁴² As the toes of the feet *were* partly of iron and partly of pottery, *so* some of the kingdom will be strong and part of it will be brittle. ⁴³ And in that you saw the iron mixed with ^[at]common clay, they will combine with one another ^[au]in the seed of men; but they will not adhere to one another, even as iron does not combine with pottery.

Rev. 13:5- There was given to him a mouth speaking [©] arrogant words and blasphemies, and authority to act for forty-two months was given to him.

Matt. 16:18- I also say to you that you are ^[l]Peter, and upon this ^[m]rock I will build My church; and the gates of Hades will not overpower it.

2 Thess. 2:8- Then that lawless one will be revealed whom the Lord will slay with the breath of His mouth and bring to an end by the appearance of His [f] coming.

Rev. 19:20- And the beast was seized, and with him the false prophet who performed the signs ^[h]in his presence, by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image; these two were thrown alive into the lake of fire which burns with ^[i]brimstone.

Rev. 20:10-And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and ^[f]brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are also; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

<u>27</u>

Zech. 14:16-18- Then it will come about that any who are left of all the nations that went against Jerusalem will go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to celebrate the Feast of Booths. ¹⁷ And it will be that whichever of the families of the earth does not go up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, there will be no rain on them. ¹⁸ If the

family of Egypt does not go up or enter, then no *rain will fall* on them; it will be the plague with which the LORD smites the nations who do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Booths.

¹⁹ This will be the ^[h]punishment of Egypt, and the ^[i]punishment of all the nations who do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Booths.

Dan. 8:27- Then I, Daniel, was [ai] exhausted and sick for days. Then I got up *again* and carried on the king's business; but I was astounded at the vision, and there was none to [ai] explain *it*.
