- He viewed the Jews as an obstacle to his goal
- He outlawed the Hebrew scriptures and executed families who observed the Sabbath and circumcision

 - Sacrificed a pig on the altar







Dan. 11:31- Forces from him will arise, desecrate the sanctuary fortress, and do away with the regular sacrifice. And they will set up the abomination [an] of desolation.
