1 John 5:14- This is the confidence which we have ^[1]before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.

Hos. 4:1-Listen to the word of the LORD, O sons of Israel, For the LORD has a case against the inhabitants of the land, Because there is no ^[a]faithfulness or ^[b]kindness Or knowledge of God in the land.

2 Chron 36:16-but they *continually* mocked the messengers of God, despised His words and scoffed at His prophets, until the wrath of the LORD arose against His people, until there was no remedy.
