





Job 9:32-33-For *He is* not a man as I am that I may answer Him, That we may go to court together. <sup>33</sup> "There is no umpire between us, Who may lay his hand upon us both.

Dan. 7:28- At this point the revelation ended. As for me, Daniel, my thoughts were greatly alarming me and my face grew pale, but I kept the matter to myself.

Dan. 8:27-Then I, Daniel, was exhausted and sick for days. Then I got up *again* and carried on the king's business; but I was astounded at the vision, and there was none to explain *it*.

Heb. 13:8-Jesus Christ *is* the same yesterday and today and forever.

Dan. 10:11- He said to me, "O Daniel, <u>man of high esteem</u>, understand the words that I am about to tell you and stand upright, for I have now been sent to you." And when he had spoken this word to me, I stood up trembling.
