Rev. 1:17- When I saw Him, I fell at His feet like a dead man. And He placed His right hand on me, saying, "**Do not be afraid**; I am the first and the last,

2 Tim. 1:7- For God has not given us a spirit of timidity, but of power and love and discipline.

12b-13a

Ezek. 28:17- Your heart was lifted up because of your beauty; **You corrupted your wisdom** by reason of your splendor. I cast you to the ground; I put you before kings, That they may see you.

Gen. 3:1- Now the serpent was more crafty than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, "**Indeed, has God said**, 'You shall not eat from any tree of the garden'?"

13b

Dan. 12:1-Now at that time <u>Michael</u>, the great prince who stands *guard* over the sons of your people, will arise. And there will be a time of distress such as never occurred since there was a nation until that time; and at that time your people, everyone who is found written in the book, will be rescued.

Eph. 6:12-For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual *forces* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*.

2 Kgs. 6:15-17- Now when the attendant of the man of God had risen early and gone out, behold, an army with horses and chariots was circling the city. And his servant said to him, "Alas, my master! What shall we do?" ¹⁶ So he answered, "Do not fear, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them." ¹⁷ Then Elisha prayed and said, "O LORD, I pray, open his eyes that he may see." And the LORD opened the servant's eyes and he saw; and behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha.

1 Tim. 2:1-2-First of all, then, I urge that entreaties *and* prayers, petitions *and* thanksgivings, be made on behalf of all men, ² for kings and all who are in authority, so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity.

<u>15-17</u>

Dan. 7:28- At this point the revelation ended. As for me, Daniel, my thoughts were greatly alarming me and my face grew pale, but I kept the matter to myself.

Dan. 8:27-Then I, Daniel, was exhausted and sick for days. Then I got up *again* and carried on the king's business; but I was astounded at the vision, and there was none to explain *it*.

<u>18-19</u>

Heb. 13:8-Jesus Christ *is* the same yesterday and today and forever.

Dan. 10:11- He said to me, "O Daniel, man of high esteem, understand the words that I am about to tell you and stand upright, for I have now been sent to you." And when he had spoken this word to me, I stood up trembling.

Dan. 9:23-At the beginning of your supplications the command was issued, and I have come to tell *you*, for you are highly esteemed; so give heed to the message and gain understanding of the vision.

Philip. 4:6-7-Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. ⁷ And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
