




Why is Daniel 11:36-45 About Antichrist and not Antiochus IV?

- 1. It does not fit the known facts of history
- 2. The king is not from the North only but is in conflict with both the North and the South
- 3. It is consistent with the prophecies about the future Antichrist (Dan. 7; 2 Thess. 2; Rev. 13; 17)
- 4. The Antichrist is prominent in Daniel's earlier prophecies ("little horn" of Dan. 7)
- 5. Prophetic gaps are common in Scripture

6 Reasons for Gap in the 70 Weeks Prophecy (Dan. 9:24-27)

- 1. Events prophesied v.26
 - Messiah crucified v.26a
 - 70 AD holocaust v.26b
- 2. Prophecies in Dan. 9:24 would have been fulfilled 7 years after Palm Sunday
- 3. Jesus indicated a gap (Matt. 24:15, 21-22, 29-30)
- 4. Daniel 9:27 was never fulfilled historically
- 5. <u>Gap occurs elsewhere (ls. 61:1-2; Luke 4:16-21; Isaiah 9:6)</u>
- 6. Early church fathers indicated a gap



Isaiah 26:20- Come, my people, enter into your rooms And close your doors behind you; Hide for a little while Until **indignation** runs *its* course.

2 Thess. 2:4- who opposes and exalts himself above every socalled god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, displaying himself as being God.

Isa. 14:12-15- "How you have fallen from heaven, O star of the morning, son of the dawn! You have been cut down to the earth, You who have weakened the nations! ¹³ "But you said in your heart, 'I will ascend to heaven; I will raise my throne above the stars of God, And I will sit on the mount of assembly In the recesses of the north. ¹⁴ 'I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will make myself like the Most High. Rev. 13:4-4 they worshiped the dragon because he gave his authority to the beast; and they worshiped the beast, saying, "Who is like the beast, and who is able to wage war with him?"

John 8:44-44 You are of *your* father the devil, and you want to do the desires of your father. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth because there is no truth in him. Whenever he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own *nature*, for he is a liar and the father of lies.

Acts 8:9-11-9 Now there was a man named Simon, who formerly was practicing magic in the city and astonishing the people of Samaria, claiming to be someone great; ¹⁰ and they all, from smallest to greatest, were giving attention to him, saying, "This man is what is called the Great Power of God." ¹¹ And they were giving him attention because he had for a long time astonished them with his magic arts.

John 6:38-³⁸ For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

Dan. 7:23- Thus he said: 'The fourth beast will be a fourth kingdom on the earth, which will be different from all the *other* kingdoms and will devour the whole earth and tread it down and crush it.

Rev. 13:7- It was also given to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them, and authority over every tribe and people and tongue and nation was given to him.

2 Thess. 2:4- who opposes and exalts himself above every socalled god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, displaying himself as being God.

Dan. 7:8- While I was contemplating the horns, behold, another horn, a little one, came up among them, and three of the first

horns were pulled out by the roots before it; and behold, this horn possessed eyes like the eyes of a man and <u>a mouth</u> <u>uttering great *boasts*</u>.

Dan. 7:11- Then I kept looking because of **the sound of the boastful words which the horn was speaking**; I kept looking until the beast was slain, and its body was destroyed and given to the burning fire.

Dan. 7:25- <u>He will speak out against the Most High</u> and wear down the saints of the Highest One, and he will intend to make alterations in times and in law; and they will be given into his hand for a time, times, and half a time.

Rev. 13:5-6-⁵ There was given to him <u>a mouth speaking</u> <u>arrogant words and blasphemies</u>, and authority to act for forty-two months was given to him. ⁶ And he opened his mouth in blasphemies against God, to blaspheme His name and His tabernacle, *that is*, those who dwell in heaven.

Matt. 12:34-You brood of vipers, how can you, being evil, speak what is good? For the mouth speaks out of that which fills the heart.

Eph. 4:29-Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such *a word* as is good for edification according to the need *of the moment*, so that it will give grace to those who hear.

Dan. 7:25- He will speak out against the Most High and wear down the saints of the Highest One, and he will intend to make alterations in times and in law; and they will be given into his hand for <u>a time</u>, <u>times</u>, <u>and half a time</u>.

Dan. 11:37 (KJV)- Neither shall he regard the God of his fathers, nor the desire of women, nor regard any god: for he shall magnify himself above all.

1 John 2:18- Children, it is the last hour; and just as you heard that **antichrist** is coming, even now many antichrists have appeared; from this we know that it is the last hour.

Luke 21:24- and they will fall by the edge of the sword, and will be led captive into all the nations; and Jerusalem will be trampled under foot by the Gentiles <u>until the times of the</u> Gentiles are fulfilled.

Dan. 7:19-20-9 "Then I desired to know the exact meaning of the fourth beast, which was different from all the others, exceedingly dreadful, with its teeth of iron and its claws of bronze, *and which* devoured, crushed and trampled down the remainder with its feet, ²⁰ and *the meaning* of the ten horns that *were* on its head and the other *horn* which came up, and before which three *of them* fell, namely, that horn which had eyes and a mouth uttering great *boasts* and which was larger in appearance than its associates.

Rev. 13:1- And the dragon stood on the sand of the seashore. Then I saw a beast coming up out of the sea, having ten horns and seven heads, and on his horns were ten diadems, and on his heads were blasphemous names.

Rev. 17:15- And he *said to me, "The waters which you saw where the harlot sits, are peoples and multitudes and nations and tongues.

Rev. 13:11-¹¹ Then I saw another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb and he spoke as a dragon.

Matt. 2:6- 'And you, Bethlehem, Land of Judah, Are by no means least among the leaders of Judah; For out of you shall come forth a Ruler Who will shepherd My people Israel.'

Luke 1:42-43-42 And she cried out with a loud voice and said, "Blessed *are* you among women, and blessed *is* the fruit of your womb! 43 And how has it *happened* to me, that the mother of my Lord would come to me?

1 John 4:3-3 and every spirit that does not confess Jesus is not from God; this is the spirit of the antichrist, of which you have heard that it is coming, and now it is already in the world.

2 Thess. 2:7- For <u>the mystery of lawlessness is already at</u> <u>work</u>; only he who now restrains *will do so* until he is taken out of the way.

Matt. 6:24- No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth. Rev. 6:1-2- Then I saw when the Lamb broke one of the seven seals, and I heard one of the four living creatures saying as with a voice of thunder, "Come." ² I looked, and behold, a white horse, and he who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer.
