Henry M. Morris, the *Defenders Bible*, page 17. “The ‘mark’ is not described. The Hebrew word *oth* is better rendered ‘sign.’ Whether the sign was a physical marking on Cain’s body or a miraculous display of some sort, it was widely known for many generations (Gen. 4:24) and did serve to inhibit any who might be inclined to slay Cain.”

Ezek. 9:4-6-⁴ And the LORD said to him, “Go through the midst of the city, through the midst of Jerusalem, and make a mark on the foreheads of the people who groan and sigh over all the abominations which are being committed in its midst.” ⁵ But to the others He said in my presence, “Go through the city after him and strike; do not let your eye have pity and do not spare. ⁶ Utterly kill old men, young men, *female* virgins, little children, and women, but do not touch any person on whom is the mark; and you shall start from My sanctuary.” So they started with the elders who *were* before the temple.
