Ps. 8:4-6- ⁴What is man that You take thought of him, And the son of man that You care for him? ⁵ Yet You have made him a little lower than God, And You crown him with glory and majesty! ⁶ You make him to rule over the works of Your hands; You have put all things under his feet.

Gen. 1:26-28- ²⁶ Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; and <u>let them rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over the cattle and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.</u>"...God blessed them; and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth, and <u>subdue it; and rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over every living thing that moves on the earth."</u>

Gen. 2:19-20-¹⁹ Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the sky, and brought *them* to the man to see what he would call them; and whatever the man called a living creature, that was its name. ²⁰ The man gave names to all the cattle, and to the birds of the sky, and to every beast of the field, but for Adam there was not found a helper suitable for him.

Job 1:7-The LORD said to Satan, "From where do you come?" Then Satan answered the LORD and said, "From roaming about on the earth and walking around on it."

Job 2:2-The LORD said to Satan, "Where have you come from?" Then Satan answered the LORD and said, "From roaming about on the earth and walking around on it."

Luke 4:5-8- And he led Him up and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. ⁶ And the devil said to Him, "I will give You all this domain and ^[c]its glory; for it has been handed over to me, and I give it to whomever I wish. ⁷ Therefore if You worship before me, it shall all be Yours." ⁸ Jesus answered him, "It is written, 'YOU SHALL WORSHIP THE LORD YOUR GOD AND SERVE HIM ONLY."

John 12:31-Now judgment is upon this world; now **the ruler of this world** will be cast out.

John 14:30- I will not speak much more with you, for **the ruler of the world** is coming, and he has nothing in Me.

John 16:11-and concerning judgment, because **the ruler of this** world has been judged.

2 Cor. 4:4- in whose case the **god of this world** has blinded the minds of the unbelieving so that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

Eph. 2:2- in which you formerly walked according to the course of this world, according to <u>the prince of the power of the air</u>, of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience.

1 John 4:4-You are from God, little children, and have overcome them; because greater is He who is in you than <u>he who is in the world</u>.

1 John 5:19- We know that we are of God, and that **the whole** world lies in *the power of* the evil one.

1 Cor. 15:45- So also it is written, "The first MAN, Adam, BECAME A LIVING SOUL." **The last Adam** became a life-giving spirit.

<u>2</u>

Gen. 2:16-17- The LORD God commanded the man, saying, "From any tree of the garden you may eat freely; ¹⁷ but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not ^[n]eat, for in the day that you eat from it **you will surely die**.

Ezek. 18:20- The person who sins will die. The son will not bear the punishment for the father's iniquity, nor will the father bear the punishment for the son's iniquity; the righteousness of the righteous will be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked will be upon himself.

Rom. 6:23- For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

1 Tim 4:10- For it is for this we labor and strive, because we have fixed our hope on the living God, who is the Savior of all men, especially of believers.

1 John 2:2-and He Himself is the propitiation for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for *those of* the **whole world**.

Gal. 4:7-Therefore you are no longer a slave, but a son; and <u>if a son, then an heir</u> through God.

Matt. 12:46-50- While He was still speaking to the crowds, behold, His mother and brothers were standing outside, seeking to speak to Him. ⁴⁷ Someone said to Him, "Behold, Your mother and Your brothers are standing outside seeking to speak to You." ⁴⁸ But Jesus answered the one who was telling Him and said, "Who is My mother and who are My brothers?" ⁴⁹ And stretching out His hand toward His disciples, He said, "Behold My mother and My brothers! ⁵⁰ For whoever does the will of My Father who is in heaven, he is My brother and sister and mother."

Rom. 8:29-30- For those whom He foreknew, He also predestined *to become* conformed to the image of His Son, so that He would be **the firstborn among many brethren**; ³⁰ and these whom He predestined, He also called; and these whom He called, He also justified; and these whom He justified, He also **glorified**.

<u>4</u>

Rev. 5:1-I saw in the right hand of Him who sat on the throne a book written inside and on the back, sealed up with seven seals.

- Rev. 5:2-4- And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, "Who is worthy to open the book and to break its seals?" And no one in heaven or on the earth or under the earth was able to open the book or to look into it. ⁴ Then I *began* to weep greatly because no one was found worthy to open the ^[e]book or to look into it
- Rev. 5:5-7-and one of the elders said to me, "Stop weeping; behold, the Lion that is from the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has overcome so as to open the book and its seven seals." And I saw between the throne (with the four living creatures) and the elders a Lamb standing, as if slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God, sent out into all the earth.
- Rev. 5:7-And He came and took the book out of the right hand of Him who sat on the throne.
- John 12:31-Now judgment is upon this world; now <u>the ruler of</u> this world will be cast out.
- John 16:11-and concerning judgment, because <u>the ruler of this</u> world has been judged.
- Col. 2:15-When He had disarmed the rulers and authorities, He made a public display of them, having triumphed over them through Him.
- 1 John 3:8-the one who practices sin is of the devil; for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The Son of God appeared for this purpose, to destroy the works of the devil.

Rev. 12:12-For this reason, rejoice, O heavens and you who dwell in them. Woe to the earth and the sea, because **the devil** has come down to you, having great wrath, **knowing that he has only a short time**.

<u>5</u>

2 Cor. 5:8- we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather **to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord**.

Philip. 1:21-23- For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. ²² But if *I am* to live *on* in the flesh, this *will mean* fruitful labor for me; and I do not know which to choose. ²³ But I am hard-pressed from both *directions*, having the desire to depart and be with Christ, for *that* is very much better.

<u>6</u>

John 14:6-Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

Acts 4:12-And there is salvation in no one else; for there is **no other name** under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved.

<u>7</u>

Propitiation-The cross has pacified, appeased, and placated God's anger against sin so that His wrath has been diverted from us.

Rom. 3:25- whom God displayed publicly as a **propitiation** in His blood through faith. *This was* to demonstrate His

righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed.

1 John 2:2-and He Himself is the **propitiation** for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for *those of* the whole world.

Ps. 40:6- Sacrifice and meal offering You have not desired; My ears You have opened; Burnt offering and sin offering You have not required.

John 19:30-Therefore when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "<u>It is finished!</u>" And He bowed His head and gave up His spirit.

Col. 2:13- When you were dead in your transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us <u>all</u> our transgressions.

Titus 2:14- who gave Himself for us to redeem us from <u>every</u> lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds.

JOHN 4:6 – and Jacob's well was there. So <u>Jesus</u>, <u>being</u> wearied from <u>His journey</u>, was sitting thus by the well. It was about the sixth hour.

MATTHEW 4:2 – And after He had fasted forty days and forty nights, **He then became hungry**.

JOHN 19:28 – After this, Jesus, knowing that all things had already been accomplished, to fulfill the Scripture, said, "<u>I am thirsty</u>."
