Gen. 4:25-26-²⁵ Adam had relations with his wife again; and <u>she</u> gave birth to a son, and <u>named him Seth</u>, for, *she said*, "God has appointed me another offspring in place of Abel, for Cain killed him." ²⁶ To <u>Seth</u>, to him also a son was born; and <u>he</u> <u>called his name Enosh</u>. Then *men* began to call upon the name of the LORD.

Jude 14-15-¹⁴ *It was* also about these men *that* Enoch, *in* the seventh *generation* from Adam, prophesied, saying, "Behold, the Lord came with many thousands of His holy ones, ¹⁵ to execute judgment upon all, and to convict all the ungodly of all their ungodly deeds which they have done in an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him."

Gen. 9:20-21-²⁰ Then <u>Noah</u> began farming and planted a vineyard. ²¹ He drank of the wine and became <u>drunk</u>, and uncovered himself inside his tent.

Gen. 9:26-He also said, "<u>Blessed</u> be the Lord, The God of <u>Shem</u>; And let Canaan be his servant."

Isa. 65:20-No longer will there be in it an infant *who lives but a few* days, Or an old man who does not live out his days; For the youth will die at the age of one hundred And the one who does not reach the age of one hundred Will be *thought* accursed.

Isa. 65:22-They will not build and another inhabit, They will not plant and another eat; For as the lifetime of a tree, *so will be* the days of My people, And My chosen ones will wear out the work of their hands.

Gen. 6:5-Then the Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great on the earth, and that <u>every intent of the thoughts of his</u> <u>heart was only evil continually</u>.
