Acts 10:1-2-¹Now *there was* a man in Caesarea named Cornelius, a centurion of what was called the Italian cohort, ² a devout man and one who feared God with all his household, and made many charitable contributions to the *Jewish* people and prayed to God continually.

Acts 11:14-and he will speak words to you by which you will be saved, you and all your household.'

<u>6</u>

Eph. 4:30-Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

1 Sam. 15:11-I regret that I have made Saul king, because he has turned back from following Me and has not carried out My commands.

<u>8</u>

Gen. 6:8 (KJV)- But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord.

Isa. 64:6- For all of us have become like one who is unclean, And all our righteous deeds are like a filthy garment; And all of us wither like a leaf,

Gen. 3:7-Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves waist coverings.

Gen. 3:21-And the LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife, and clothed them.

Josh. 24:2-3-² Joshua said to all the people, "This is what the LORD, the God of Israel says: 'From ancient times your fathers lived beyond the *Euphrates* River, *namely*, Terah, the father of Abraham and the father of Nahor, and they <u>served</u> <u>other gods</u>. ³ Then I took your father Abraham from beyond the *Euphrates* River and led him through all the land of Canaan, and multiplied his descendants and gave him Isaac.

Rom. 3:10- as it is written: "THERE IS NO RIGHTEOUS PERSON, NOT EVEN ONE;"

Eph. 2:8-9-⁸ For by grace you have been saved through faith; and this *is* not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; ⁹ not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

Titus 3:5-He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we did in righteousness, but in accordance with His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit.

<u>9</u>

Gen. 3:8-Now they heard the sound of the LORD God <u>walking</u> <u>in the garden in the cool of the day</u>, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden.

Gen. 5:24-Enoch <u>walked with God</u>; and he was not, for God took him.

Philip. 3:9-and may be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own derived from the Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which comes from God on the basis of faith. Gen. 2:4-This is <u>the account</u> of the heavens and the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made earth and heaven.

Gen. 5:1-This is the book of <u>the generations</u> of Adam. On the day when God created man, He made him in the likeness of God.

<u>10</u>

1 Cor. 7:14-For the unbelieving husband is sanctified through his wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified through her believing husband; for otherwise your children are unclean, but now they are holy.

Acts 16:30-31-³⁰ and after he brought them out, he said, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" ³¹ They said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, <u>you and your household</u>."

Exod. 20:5-6-⁵ You shall not worship them nor serve them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, inflicting the punishment of the fathers on the children, on the third and the fourth generations of those who hate Me, ⁶ but showing favor to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.

Gen. 5:32-Now after Noah was five hundred years old, Noah fathered Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

Gen. 9:26- He also said, "<u>Blessed be the LORD, The God of</u> <u>Shem</u>; And may Canaan be his servant." Gen. 11:10-These are *the records of* the generations of <u>Shem</u>. Shem was a hundred years old when he fathered Arpachshad, two years after the flood

Gen. 11:32-The days of <u>**Terah**</u> were 205 years; and Terah died in Haran.

Gen. 9:22-Ham, the father of Canaan, saw the nakedness of his father, and told his two brothers outside.

Gen. 9:25- So he said, "Cursed be Canaan; A servant of servants He shall be to his brothers."

Gen. 9:26- He also said, "Blessed be the Lord, The God of Shem; And <u>may Canaan be his servant</u>."

<u>11-12</u>

Zech. 12:12-The **land** will mourn, every family by itself; the family of the house of David by itself and their wives by themselves; the family of the house of Nathan by itself and their wives by themselves.

<u>13</u>

Gen. 4:23-24-²³ If Cain is avenged seven times, Then Lamech seventy-seven times!" Lamech said to his wives, "Adah and Zillah, Listen to my voice, You wives of Lamech, Pay attention to my words, For I have killed a man for wounding me; And a boy for striking me!"²⁴ If Cain is avenged seven times, Then Lamech seventy-seven times!"
