1 Cor. 11:7- For a man ought not to have his head covered, since he is <u>the image and glory of God</u>; but the woman is the glory of man.

#### 1 John 4:20- If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; <u>for the one who does not love his brother</u> <u>whom he has seen, cannot love God whom he has not seen</u>.

#### <u>11</u>

Matt. 16:13-23-<sup>13</sup> Now when Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, He was asking His disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" <sup>14</sup> And they said, "Some say John the Baptist; and others, Elijah; but still others, Jeremiah, or one of the prophets." <sup>15</sup>He \*said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" <sup>16</sup> Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." <sup>17</sup> And Jesus said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Barjona, because flesh and blood did not reveal this to you, but My Father who is in heaven. <sup>18</sup> I also say to you that you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build My church; and the gates of Hades will not overpower it. <sup>19</sup> I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; and whatever you bind on earth shall have been bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall have been loosed in heaven."<sup>20</sup> Then He warned the disciples that they should tell no one that He was the Christ.<sup>21</sup> From that time Jesus began to show His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised up on the third day.<sup>22</sup> Peter took Him aside and began to rebuke Him, saying, "God forbid *it*, Lord! This shall never happen to You." <sup>23</sup> But He turned and said to Peter, "<u>Get behind Me, Satan</u>! You are a stumbling block to Me; for you are not setting your mind on God's interests, but man's."

#### <u>12</u>

Gen. 1:24-Then God said, "Let the earth produce living creatures <u>according to their kind</u>: livestock and crawling things and animals of the earth <u>according to their kind</u>"; and it was so.

Jas. 1:18-In the exercise of His will He gave us birth by the word of truth, so that we would be a kind of first fruits among His creatures.

Matt. 12:34-You brood of vipers, how can you, being evil, speak what is good? For the mouth speaks out of that which fills the heart.

Matt. 12:36- But I tell you that every careless word that people speak, they shall give an accounting for it in the day of judgment.

Jas. 1:22-But prove yourselves <u>doers</u> of the word, and not just hearers who deceive themselves.

John 13:17-If you **know** these things, you are **blessed** if you **do** them.

1 Tim. 6:20 (KJV)- O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of <u>science falsely so called</u>:

Prov. 6:34-For **jealousy** enrages a man, And he will not have compassion on the day of vengeance.

Prov. 16:18-<u>Pride</u> *goes* before destruction, And <u>a haughty</u> <u>spirit</u> before stumbling.

3 John 9-I wrote something to the church; but **<u>Diotrephes, who</u> <u>loves to be first among them</u>**, does not accept what we say.

Prov. 8:13-The fear of the LORD is to hate evil; **<u>Pride</u>**, **<u>arrogance</u>**, the evil way, And the perverted mouth, I hate.

Prov. 14:12-There is a way *which* <u>seems</u> right to a person, But its end is the way of death.

Prov. 27:20-<u>Sheol and Abaddon</u> are never satisfied, Nor are the eyes of a person ever satisfied.

Matt. 16:23-But He turned and said to Peter, "<u>Get behind</u> <u>Me, Satan</u>! You are a stumbling block to Me; for you are not setting your mind on God's interests, but man's."

Prov. 15:26-Evil plans are an abomination to the LORD, But pleasant words are **<u>pure</u>**.

Prov. 3:1-2-<sup>1</sup>My son, do not forget my teaching, But have your heart comply with my commandments; <sup>2</sup> For length of days and years of life And <u>peace</u> they will add to you.

Eph. 2:14-For He Himself is our **<u>peace</u>**, who made both *groups into* one and broke down the barrier of the dividing wall.

Prov. 16:32-One who is **<u>slow to anger</u>** is better than the mighty, And one who rules his spirit, than one who captures a city.

Prov. 14:15-The naive believes everything, But the sensible person <u>considers</u> his steps.

Prov. 11:17-A <u>merciful</u> person does himself *good*, But the cruel person does himself harm.
