Acts 16:30-31-<sup>30</sup> and after he brought them out, he said, “Sirs, what must I do to be saved?” <sup>31</sup> They said, “Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, **you and your household.**”

John 1:12-13-<sup>12</sup> But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who **believe** in His name, <sup>13</sup> who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of a man, but of God.

Heb. 11:6-7-<sup>6</sup> And **without faith it is impossible to please Him**, for the one who comes to God must believe that He exists, and *that* He proves to be One who rewards those who seek Him. <sup>7</sup> **By faith** Noah, being warned *by God* about things not yet seen, in reverence prepared an ark for the salvation of his household, by which he condemned the world, and became an heir of the righteousness which is according to faith.

Heb. 11:4-By faith Abel offered to God a better sacrifice than Cain, through which he was attested to be righteous, God testifying about his gifts, and through faith, though he is dead, he still speaks.

Gen. 3:21-And the Lord God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife, and clothed them.

Gen. 15:6 (NIV)-**Abram believed the Lord**, and He **credited** it to him as righteousness.

2 Cor. 6:2-<sup>2</sup> for He says, “At a favorable time I listened to you, And on a day of salvation I helped you.” Behold, now is “a favorable time,” behold, **now is “a day of salvation”**—

Matt. 24:21-22-<sup>21</sup> For then there will be a great tribulation, such as has not occurred since the beginning of the world until now, nor ever will *again*. <sup>22</sup> And if those days had not been cut short, no life would have been saved; but for the sake of the elect those days will be cut short.

Matt. 6:24-“No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth.”

1 Sam. 15:22-Samuel said, “Does the Lord have as much delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices As in obeying the voice of the Lord? Behold, **to obey is better than a sacrifice**, *And* to pay attention is *better* than the fat of rams.”

Isa. 65:20-No longer will there be in it an infant *who lives only a few* days, Or an old person who does not live out his days; For the youth will die at the age of a hundred, And the one who does not reach the age of a hundred Will be *thought* accursed.

Isa. 65:23-They will not build and another inhabit, They will not plant and another eat; **For as the lifetime of a tree, so will be the days of My people, And My chosen ones will fully enjoy the work of their hands.**

Ps. 90:10-As for the days of our life, they contain **seventy years,** **Or if due to strength, eighty years,** Yet their pride

is *only* trouble and tragedy; For it quickly passes, and we disappear.

1 Pet. 3:20—who once were disobedient when the patience of God kept waiting in the days of Noah, during the construction of the ark, in which a few, that is, **eight persons**, were brought safely through *the water*.

2 Pet. 2:5—and did not spare the ancient world, but protected **Noah**, a preacher of righteousness, **with seven others**, when He brought a flood upon the world of the ungodly.

Gen. 8:4—Then in **the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month**, the ark rested upon the mountains of Ararat.

Gen. 2:5-6-<sup>5</sup> Now no shrub of the field was yet on the earth, and no plant of the field had yet sprouted, for the Lord God had not sent rain upon the earth, and there was no man to cultivate the ground. <sup>6</sup> But a mist used to rise from the earth and water the whole surface of the ground.

Gen. 8:2—Also the fountains of the **deep** and the floodgates of the **sky** were closed, and the rain from the sky was restrained.

Gen. 1:6-7-<sup>6</sup> Then God said, “Let there be an **expanse** in the midst of the waters, and let it separate the waters from the waters.” <sup>7</sup> God made the expanse, and separated the **waters that were below the expanse** from **the waters that were above the expanse**; and it was so.

Ps. 148:4-Praise Him, highest heavens, And **the waters that are above the heavens!**

Josh. 10:12-13-Then Joshua spoke to the Lord on the day when the Lord turned the Amorites over to the sons of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel, “**Sun, stand still** at Gibeon, And moon, at the Valley of Aijalon! So, **the sun stood still**, and the moon stopped, Until the nation avenged themselves of their enemies. Is it not written in the Book of Jashar? And **the sun stopped in the middle of the sky and did not hurry to go down for about a whole day.**
