John 3:16-For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

Constable- Many commentators interpreted the final sentence in this verse as an indication that Jesus ended His discourse here, and that He and the Eleven left the upper room immediately. They viewed the teaching and praying, that we find in chapters 15—17, as happening somewhere in Jerusalem near the Kidron Valley—before Jesus' arrest (cf. 18:1).<sup>627</sup> However, it seems more probable to many interpreters, including myself, that this sentence did not signal a real change of location—but only an anticipated change, in view of 18:1.

Heb 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep <sup>[a]</sup>through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, <sup>21</sup> equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
