John 15:4-5-Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit [a] of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither *can*

you unless you abide in Me. ⁵ I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing.

John 14:27-Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful.

Philip 4:7-And the peace of God, which surpasses all ^[d]comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus

Jas 1:2-4-Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various ^[a]trials, ³ knowing that the testing of your faith produces ^[b]endurance. ⁴ And let ^[c]endurance have *its* perfect ^[d]result, so that you may be ^[e]perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

Rom 5:8-But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

John 2:23-25-Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, during the feast, many believed in His name, observing His signs which He was doing. ²⁴ But Jesus, on His part, was not entrusting Himself to them, for He knew all men, ²⁵ and because He did not need anyone to testify concerning man, for He Himself knew what was in man.

Matt 4:20-Immediately they left their nets and followed Him.

Eph 1:4-just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before ^[a]Him. In love

1 Cor. 3:15-If any man's work is burned up, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.

John 15:6-If anyone does not abide in Me, he is thrown away as a branch and dries up; and they gather them, and cast them into the fire and they are burned.

1 John 5:14-This is the confidence which we have ^[a]before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.

Jas 4:2-3-You lust and do not have; so you commit murder. You are envious and cannot obtain; so you fight and quarrel. You do

not have because you do not ask. ³ You ask and do not receive, because you ask ^[a] with wrong motives, so that you may spend *it* ^[b] on your pleasures.
