John 12:31-Now judgment is upon this world; now the ruler of this world will be cast out.

John 14:30-I will not speak much more with you, for the ruler of the world is coming, and he has nothing in Me.

John 16:11-and concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world has been judged.

1 John 5:19-We know that we are of God, and that the whole world lies in *the power of* the evil one.

1 John 2:15-17-Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. ¹⁶ For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world. ¹⁷ The world is passing away, and *also* its lusts; but the one who does the will of God lives forever.

Jas 4:4-You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.

John 17:15-I do not ask You to take them out of the world, but to keep them ^[a]from ^[b]the evil *one*.

John 15:16-You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and *that* your fruit would remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give to you.

2 Tim. 3:12-Indeed, all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will be persecuted.

John 13:14-16-¹⁴ If I then, the Lord and the Teacher, washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. ¹⁵ For I gave you an example that you also should do as I did to you. ¹⁶ Truly, truly, I say to you, a slave is not greater than his master, nor *is* one who is sent greater than the one who sent him. ¹⁷ If you know these things, you are blessed if you do them.

1 Sam. 8:5-7-⁵ and they said to him, "Behold, you have grown old, and your sons do not walk in your ways. Now appoint a king for us to judge us like all the nations." ⁶ But the thing was ^[a]displeasing in the sight of Samuel when they said, "Give us a king to judge us." And Samuel prayed to the LORD. ⁷ The LORD said to Samuel, "Listen to the voice of the people in regard to all that they say to you, for they have not rejected you, but they have rejected Me from being king over them.

John 7:7-The world cannot hate you, but it hates Me because I testify of it, that its deeds are evil.

John 3:19-20- This is the judgment, that the Light has come into the world, and men loved the darkness rather than the Light, for their deeds were evil. ²⁰ For everyone who does evil hates the Light, and does not come to the Light for fear that his deeds will be exposed.

Matt 23:34-Therefore, behold, I am sending you prophets and wise men and scribes; some of them you will kill and crucify, and some of them you will scourge in your synagogues, and persecute from city to city.

Rev. 11:3, 7-10-And I will grant *authority* to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy for twelve hundred and sixty days, clothed in sackcloth... When they have finished their testimony, the beast that comes up out of the abyss will make war with them, and overcome them and kill them. ⁸ And their dead bodies *will lie* in the street of the great city which ^[f]mystically is called Sodom and Egypt, where also their Lord was crucified. ⁹ Those from the peoples and tribes and tongues and nations *will* look at their dead ^[g]bodies for three and a half days, and ^[h]will not permit their dead bodies to be laid in a tomb. ¹⁰ And those who dwell on the earth *will* rejoice over them and celebrate; and they will send gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those who dwell on the earth.

1 Thess 5:5-for you are all sons of light and sons of day. We are not of night nor of darkness.

Matt. 5:14-16-You are the light of the world. A city set on a ^[a]hill cannot be hidden; ¹⁵ nor does *anyone* light a lamp and put it under a ^[b]basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. ¹⁶ Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

Eph. 5:11-Do not participate in the unfruitful deeds of darkness, but instead even ^[a]expose them.

John 5:19-Therefore Jesus answered and was saying to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, unless *it is* something He sees the Father doing; for whatever ^[a]the Father does, these things the Son also does in like manner.

John 1:4-5-In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men. ⁵ The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not ^[a]comprehend it.

John 3:19-20- This is the judgment, that the Light has come into the world, and men loved the darkness rather than the Light, for their deeds were evil. ²⁰ For everyone who does evil hates the Light, and does not come to the Light for fear that his deeds will be exposed.

John 3:16- For God so loved the world, that He gave His ^[a]only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

Ps 35:19- Do not let those who are wrongfully my enemies rejoice over me; Nor let those who hate me without cause ^[a]wink maliciously.

Ps 69:4- Those who hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of my head; Those who would ^[a]destroy me are powerful, being wrongfully my enemies; What I did not steal, I then have to restore.

Heb. 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep ^[a]through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, ²¹ equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
