Philip. 3:9-and may be found in Him, not having a <u>righteousness</u> of my own derived from *the* Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the <u>righteousness</u> which *comes* from God on the basis of faith

Ps. 66:18- If I regard wickedness in my heart, The Lord will not hear.

Matt. 5:23-24-<sup>23</sup> Therefore, if you are presenting your offering at the altar, and there you remember that your brother has something against you, <sup>24</sup> leave your offering there before the altar and go; first be reconciled to your brother, and then come and present your offering.

1 Pet. 3:7-You husbands in the same way, live with *your* wives in an understanding way, as with someone weaker, *since* she is a woman; and show her honor as a fellow heir of the grace of life, so that your prayers will not be hindered.

## 17-18

1 Kgs. 17:1- Now Elijah the Tishbite, who was of the settlers of Gilead, said to Ahab, "As the LORD, the God of Israel lives, before whom I stand, there shall certainly be <u>neither dew nor rain</u> during these years, except by my word."

1 Kgs. 18:42-So Ahab went up to eat and drink. But Elijah went up to the top of Carmel; and he **bent down to the earth** and put his face between his knees.

- 1 Kgs. 18:45-Meanwhile the sky became dark with clouds and wind *came up*, and **there was a heavy shower**. And Ahab rode and went to Jezreel.
- Ezek. 14:14-even *though* these three men, **Noah, Daniel and Job** were in its midst, by their *own* righteousness they could *only* deliver themselves," declares the Lord GoD.
- Ezek. 14:20-even *though* Noah, Daniel and Job were in its midst, as I live," declares the Lord GoD, "they could not deliver either *their* son or *their* daughter. They would deliver only themselves by their righteousness."
- Acts 14:15-and saying, "Men, why are you doing these things? We are also **men, of the same nature as you**, preaching the gospel to you, to turn from these useless things to a living God, who MADE THE HEAVEN AND THE EARTH AND THE SEA, AND EVERYTHING THAT IS IN THEM.
- 1 Kgs. 19:4-But he himself went a day's journey into the wilderness, and came and sat down under a broom tree; **and he asked for himself to die**, and said, "Enough! Now, LORD, take my life, for I am no better than my fathers."
- Luke 4:25-But I say to you in truth, there were many widows in Israel in the days of <u>Elijah</u>, when the sky was shut up for three years and six months, when a severe famine came over all the land.
- Rev. 11:3-And I will grant *authority* to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy for **1,260 days**, clothed in sackcloth.

Rev. 11:6- These have the power to shut up the sky, so that rain will not fall during the days of their prophesying; and they have power over the waters to turn them into blood, and to strike the earth with every plague, as often as they desire.

## <u> 19</u>

Matt. 7:1-5-"Do not judge, so that you will not be judged. <sup>2</sup> For in the way you judge, you will be judged; and by your standard of measure, it will be measured to you. <sup>3</sup> Why do you look at the speck that is in your brother's eye, but do not notice the log that is in your own eye? <sup>4</sup> Or how can you say to your brother, 'Let me take the speck out of your eye,' and look, the log is in your own eye? <sup>5</sup> You hypocrite, first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your brother's eye!

Gal. 6:1-Brothers *and sisters*, even if a person is caught in any wrongdoing, you who are spiritual are to restore such a person **in a spirit of gentleness**; *each one* looking to yourself, so that you are not tempted as well.

## **20**

Philip. 1:19-for I know that this will turn out for **my deliverance** through your prayers and the provision of the Spirit of Jesus Christ.

Rom. 6:23-For <u>the wages of sin</u> is death, but the gracious gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Prov. 13:15 (KJV)-Good understanding giveth favour: but <u>the</u> <u>way of transgressors is hard</u>.

Gal. 6:6-9-<sup>6</sup> The one who is taught the word is to share all good things with the one who teaches *him*. <sup>7</sup> Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a person sows, this he will also reap. <sup>8</sup> For the one who sows to his own flesh will reap destruction from the flesh, but the one who sows to the Spirit will reap eternal life from the Spirit. <sup>9</sup> Let's not become discouraged in doing good, for in due time we will reap, if we do not become weary.

Acts 5:1-11-But a man named Ananias, with his wife Sapphira, sold a piece of property, <sup>2</sup> and kept back some of the proceeds for himself, with his wife's full knowledge, and bringing a portion of it, he laid it at the apostles' feet. <sup>3</sup> But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and to keep back some of the proceeds of the land? <sup>4</sup> While it remained *unsold*, did it not remain your own? And after it was sold, was it not under your control? Why is it that you have conceived this deed in your heart? You have not lied to men, but to God." 5 And as he heard these words, Ananias collapsed and died; and great fear came over all who heard about it. <sup>6</sup> The young men got up and covered him up, and after carrying him out, they buried him. <sup>7</sup> Now an interval of about three hours elapsed, and his wife came in, not knowing what had happened. <sup>8</sup> And Peter responded to her, "Tell me whether you sold the land for this price?" And she said, "Yes, for that price." <sup>9</sup> Then Peter said to her, "Why is it that you have agreed together to put the Spirit of the Lord to the test? Behold, the feet of those who have buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out as well." 10 And immediately she collapsed at his feet and died; and the young men came in

and found her dead, and they carried her out and buried her beside her husband. <sup>11</sup> And great fear came over the whole church, and over all who heard *about* these things.

1 Cor. 11:30-For this reason many among you are weak and sick, and a number are asleep.

1 John 5:16-If anyone sees his brother *or sister* committing a sin not *leading* to death, he shall ask and *God* will, for him, give life to those who commit sin not *leading* to death. There is sin *leading* to death; I am not saying that he should ask about that.

Rev. 2:22-23-<sup>23</sup> And <u>I will kill her children</u> with plague, and all the churches will know that I am He who searches the minds and hearts; and I will give to each one of you according to your deeds. <sup>24</sup> But I say to you, the rest who are in Thyatira, who do not hold this teaching, who have not known the deep things of Satan, as they call them—I place no other burden on you.

1 Peter 4:8-Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because **love covers a multitude of sins**.
