Gen. 10:6-The sons of <u>Ham</u> were Cush, Mizraim, Put, and <u>Canaan</u>.

Gen. 5:32-Now after Noah was five hundred years old, Noah fathered <u>Shem, Ham, and Japheth</u>.

Gen. 6:10-And Noah fathered three sons: Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

Gen. 7:13-On this very same day <u>Noah, Shem, Ham</u>, and Japheth, the sons of Noah, and Noah's wife and the three wives of his sons with them, entered the ark

Gen. 10:1-Now these are *the records of* the generations of the sons of Noah: <u>Shem, Ham, and Japheth</u>; and sons were born to them after the flood.

1 Chron. 1:4-Noah, Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

## <u>20</u>

2 Cor. 5:17-Therefore if anyone is in Christ, *this person is* a <u>**new creation**</u>; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.

Rev. 21:1-Then I saw a <u>new heaven and a new earth</u>; for the first heaven and the first earth passed away, and there is no longer *any* sea.

Titus 3:5-He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we did in righteousness, but in accordance with His mercy, by the washing of <u>regeneration</u> and renewing by the Holy Spirit.

Lam. 3:22-23-<sup>22</sup> The LORD'S acts of mercy indeed do not end, For His compassions do not fail. <sup>23</sup> *They* are <u>new every</u> <u>morning</u>; Great is Your faithfulness.

# <u>21</u>

1 Tim. 5:23-Do not go on drinking only water, but use a little **wine** for the sake of your stomach and your frequent ailments.

Eph. 5:18-And do not get <u>drunk</u> with wine, in which there is debauchery, but be filled with the Spirit.

Lam. 4:21-Rejoice and be joyful, daughter of Edom, Who lives in the land of Uz; *But* the cup will pass to you as well, <u>You will</u> <u>become drunk and expose yourself</u>.

Hab. 2:15-"Woe to him who makes his neighbor drink; To you who mix in your venom even to make *your neighbors* <u>drunk, So</u> <u>as to look at their genitalia!</u>

Heb. 11:7-<u>By faith Noah</u>, being warned by God about things not yet seen, in reverence prepared an ark for the salvation of his household, by which he condemned the world, and became <u>an</u> <u>heir of the righteousness which is according to faith</u>.

1 Samuel 28:19-Furthermore, the LORD will also hand Israel along with you over to the Philistines; so <u>tomorrow you and</u> <u>your sons will be with me</u>. Indeed, the LORD will hand the army of Israel over to the Philistines!

1 Kings. 11:4-For <u>when Solomon was old, his wives turned</u> <u>his heart away to follow other gods</u>; and <u>his heart was</u> <u>not wholly devoted to the LORD his God</u>, as the heart of his father David *had been*. John 2:23-25-<sup>23</sup> Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, during the feast, many <u>believed in His name</u> as they observed His signs which He was doing. <sup>24</sup> But Jesus, on His part, was not entrusting Himself to them, because He knew all people, <sup>25</sup> and because He did not need anyone to testify about mankind, for He Himself knew what was in mankind.

John 12:42-Nevertheless many, even of the rulers, <u>believed in</u> <u>Him, but because of the Pharisees they were not</u> <u>confessing *Him*</u>, so that they would not be excommunicated from the synagogue.

Acts 5:11-And great fear came over the whole church, and over all who heard *about* these things.

Acts 8:13-Now even Simon himself <u>believed</u>; and after being baptized, he continued on with Philip, and as he observed signs and great miracles taking place, he was *repeatedly* amazed.

2 Tim. 4:10-for **Demas, having loved this present world, has deserted me** and gone to Thessalonica; Crescens *has gone* to Galatia, Titus to Dalmatia.

Col. 4:14-Luke, the beloved physician, sends you his greetings, and **Demas** *does also*.

Heb. 5:11-14-<sup>11</sup> Concerning him we have much to say, and *it is* difficult to explain, since you have become poor listeners. <sup>12</sup> For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you have need again for someone to teach you the elementary principles of the actual words of God, and you have come to need milk and not solid food. <sup>13</sup> For everyone who partakes *only* of milk is unacquainted with the word of righteousness, for he is an infant. <sup>14</sup> But solid food is for the mature, who because of practice have their senses trained to distinguish between good and evil.

Rev. 3:19-<u>Those whom I love, I rebuke and discipline</u>; therefore be zealous and repent.

1 Pet. 1:5-who are **protected by the power of God** through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in *the* last time.

## <u>22</u>

Gen. 10:6-The sons of <u>Ham</u> were Cush, Mizraim, Put, and <u>Canaan</u>.

Lev. 18:18-And you shall not <u>marry</u> a woman in addition to her <u>sister</u> as a second wife while she is alive, to <u>uncover her</u> <u>nakedness</u>.

## <u>25</u>

Gen. 10:6-The sons of <u>Ham</u> were Cush, Mizraim, Put, and <u>Canaan</u>.

Ezek. 18:19-20-<sup>19</sup> "Yet you say, 'Why should the son not suffer *the punishment* for the father's guilt?' When the son has practiced justice and righteousness *and* has kept all My statutes and done them, he shall certainly live. <sup>20</sup> The person who sins will die. <u>A son will not suffer *the punishment* for the father's</u> <u>guilt, nor will a father suffer *the punishment* for the son's <u>guilt; the righteousness of the righteous will be upon himself</u>.</u> Gen. 15:16-Then in the fourth generation they will return here, for the wrongdoing of the Amorite is not yet complete.

## <u>26</u>

Gen. 14:1-4- <sup>1</sup> And it came about in the days of Amraphel king of Shinar, Arioch king of Ellasar, <u>Chedorlaomer king of Elam</u>, and Tidal king of Goiim, <sup>2</sup> that they made war with Bera king of Sodom, and with Birsha king of Gomorrah, Shinab king of Admah, and Shemeber king of Zeboiim, and the king of Bela (that is, Zoar). <sup>3</sup> <u>All these kings came as allies to the Valley of</u> <u>Siddim</u> (that is, the Salt Sea). <sup>4</sup> For twelve years <u>they</u> had served <u>Chedorlaomer</u>, but *in* the thirteenth year they rebelled.

1 Kgs. 9:20-21-<sup>20</sup> As for all the people who were left of the <u>Amorites, the Hittites, the Perizzites, the Hivites, and the</u> <u>Jebusites</u>, who were not of the sons of Israel, <sup>21</sup> their descendants who were left after them in the land, whom <u>the</u> <u>sons of Israel</u> were unable to completely eliminate, from them Solomon <u>conscripted forced laborers</u>, *as they are* to this day.

Gal. 3:28-There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

#### <u>29</u>

Gen. 7:6-Now <u>Noah was six hundred years old</u> when the <u>flood</u> of water came upon the earth.

Acts 13:39 (NIV)-Now <u>when David had served God's</u> <u>purpose in his own generation, he fell asleep</u>; he was buried with his ancestors and his body decayed. Dan. 12:4-But as for you, Daniel, keep these words secret and seal up the book until the end of time; many will roam about, and knowledge will increase.

Dan. 12:8-9-<sup>8</sup> But as for me, I heard but did not understand; so I said, "My lord, what *will be* the outcome of these *events*?" <sup>9</sup> And he said, "Go *your way*, Daniel, for *these* words *will be* kept secret and sealed up until the end time.

Eph. 2:10-For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would <u>walk</u> in them.
