Gen. 3:22-"Behold, <u>the man has become like one of Us,</u> <u>knowing good and evil</u>; and now, he might reach out with his hand, and take *fruit* also from the tree of life, and eat, and live forever"—

Isa. 6:8-Then I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for <u>Us</u>?" Then I said, "Here am I. Send me!"

Eph. 4:6-one <u>God and Father</u> of all who is over all and through all and in all.

John 8:58-59-<sup>58</sup> Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, <u>I am</u>." <sup>59</sup> Therefore they picked up stones to throw at Him, but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple.

Acts 5:3-4-<sup>3</sup> But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to <u>lie to the Holy Spirit</u> and to keep back *some* of the price of the land? <sup>4</sup> While it remained *unsold*, did it not remain your own? And after it was sold, was it not under your control? Why is it that you have conceived this deed in your heart? You have not <u>lied to men but to God</u>."

Deut. 6:4-Hear, O Israel! The LORD is our God, <u>the LORD is</u> <u>one</u>!

Acts 2:5-8-<sup>5</sup> Now there were Jews residing in Jerusalem, devout men from every nation under heaven. <sup>6</sup> And when this sound occurred, the crowd came together and they were bewildered, because each one of them was hearing them speak in his **<u>own language</u>**. <sup>7</sup> They were amazed and astonished, saying, "Why, are not all these who are speaking Galileans? <sup>8</sup> And how *is it that* we each hear *them* in our <u>**own language**</u> to which we were born?

Zephaniah 3:9-**For then I will restore to the peoples pure lips**, So that all of them may call on the name of the Lord, To serve Him shoulder to shoulder.

Gen. 10:5-From these *the people of* the coastlands of the nations were separated into their lands, every one according to his **language**, according to their families, into their nations.

Gen. 10:20-These are the sons of Ham, according to their families, according to their **languages**, by their lands, *and* by their nations.

Gen. 10:31-These are the sons of Shem, according to their families, according to their <u>languages</u>, by their lands, *and* according to their nations.

Gen. 10:10-12-<sup>10</sup> And the beginning of his kingdom was Babel, Erech, Accad, and Calneh, in the land of <u>Shinar</u>. <sup>11</sup> From that land he went to <u>Assyria</u>, and built Nineveh, Rehoboth-Ir, Calah, <sup>12</sup> and Resen between Nineveh and Calah; that is the great city.
