<u>No. 1</u>

Matt. 1:17-Thus there were <u>fourteen</u> generations in all from <u>Abraham to David</u>, <u>fourteen</u> from <u>David to the exile</u> to Babylon, and <u>fourteen</u> from the <u>exile to the Messiah</u>.

1 Kgs. 6:1-In the <u>four hundred and eightieth year</u> after the Israelites came out of <u>Egypt</u>, in the <u>fourth year of Solomon's</u> <u>reign</u> over Israel, in the month of Ziv, the second month, he began to build the <u>temple</u> of the LORD.

Exod. 12:40-Now the length of time the Israelite people lived in Egypt was <u>430 years</u>.

Ps. 11:3-If the **<u>foundations</u>** are destroyed, What can the righteous do?

<u>No. 3</u>

Gen. 1:6-7-⁶ Then God said, "Let there be an expanse in the midst of the waters, and let it separate the waters from the waters." ⁷ God made the expanse, and separated the waters which were below the expanse from <u>the waters which were</u> <u>above the expanse</u>; and it was so.

Ps. 148:4-Praise Him, highest heavens, And <u>the waters that are</u> <u>above</u> the heavens!

Gen. 1:24-25-²⁴ Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth <u>living</u> <u>creatures</u> after their kind: <u>cattle and creeping things</u> and <u>beasts</u> of the earth after their kind"; and it was so. ²⁵ God made the <u>beasts of the earth</u> after their kind, and the <u>cattle</u> after their kind, and <u>everything that creeps on the ground</u> after its kind; and God saw that it was good.

Gen. 2:5-6-⁵ Now no shrub of the field was yet in the earth, and no plant of the field had yet sprouted, for <u>the LORD God had</u> <u>not sent rain upon the earth</u>, and there was no man to cultivate the ground. ⁶ But <u>a mist used to rise from the earth and water</u> <u>the whole surface</u> of the ground.

Ps. 90:10-As for the days of our life, they contain <u>seventy years</u>, <u>Or if due to strength, eighty years</u>, Yet their pride is *but* labor and sorrow; For soon it is gone and we fly away.
