Acts 5:33-39-<sup>33</sup> But when they heard *this*, they became infuriated and *nearly* decided to execute them. <sup>34</sup> But a Pharisee named Gamaliel, a teacher of the Law, respected by all the people, stood up in the Council and gave orders to put the men outside for a short time. <sup>35</sup> And he said to them, "Men of Israel, be careful as to what you are about to do with these men. <sup>36</sup> For, some time ago Theudas appeared, claiming to be somebody, and a group of about four hundred men joined him. But he was

Lev. 25:23-The land, moreover, shall not be sold permanently, because **the land is Mine**; for you are *only* strangers and residents with Me.

<u>2</u>

Deut. 26:5- And you shall respond and say before the LORD your God, 'My father was a wandering Aramean, and he went down to Egypt and resided there, few in number; but there he became a great, mighty, and **populous nation**.

Gen. 13:2- Now **Abram was very rich** in livestock, silver, and gold.

Zech. 8:23-The LORD of armies says this: 'In those days ten people from all the nations will grasp the garment of a Jew, saying, "Let us go with you, for we have heard that God is with you.""

Isa. 42:6- I am the LORD, I have called You in righteousness, I will also hold You by the hand and watch over You, And I will appoint You as a covenant to the people, As <u>a light to the nations</u>.

Isa. 49:6- He says, "It is too small a thing that You should be My Servant To raise up the tribes of Jacob and to restore the protected ones of Israel; I will also make You a light of the nations So that My salvation may reach to the end of the earth."
