### Cross References

Isaiah 55:8-9-“For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways,” declares the LORD. <sup>9</sup>“For *as* the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways And My thoughts than your thoughts.

John 10:40-And He went away again beyond the Jordan to the place where John was first baptizing, and He was staying there.

Luke 10:38-42- Now as they were traveling along, He entered a village; and a woman named Martha welcomed Him into her home. <sup>39</sup> She had a sister called Mary, who was seated at the Lord’s feet, listening to His

word.<sup>40</sup> But Martha was distracted with all her preparations; and she came up *to Him* and said, “Lord, do You not care that my sister has left me to do all the serving alone? Then tell her to help me.”<sup>41</sup> But the Lord answered and said to her, “Martha, Martha, you are worried and bothered about so many things;<sup>42</sup> but *only* one thing is necessary, for Mary has chosen the good part, which shall not be taken away from her.

Genesis 3:12-The man said, “The woman whom You gave *to be* with me, she gave me from the tree, and I ate.”

Dan 12:2- Many of those who sleep in the dust of the ground will awake, these to everlasting life, but the others to disgrace *and* everlasting contempt.

Acts 24:15- having a hope in God, which these men cherish themselves, that there shall certainly be a resurrection of both the righteous and the wicked.

John 5:28-29- Do not marvel at this; for an hour is coming, in which all who are in the tombs will hear His voice,<sup>29</sup> and will come forth; those who did the good *deeds* to a resurrection of life, those who committed the evil *deeds* to a resurrection of judgment.

Exod 3:14- God said to Moses, “I AM WHO I AM”; and He said, “Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, ‘I AM has sent me to you.’”

Dan 12:2- Many of those who sleep in the dust of the ground will awake, these to everlasting life, but the others to disgrace *and* everlasting contempt.

Eph 2:1- And you were dead in your trespasses and sins.

John 3:16- For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

Heb 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, <sup>21</sup> equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
