Cross References

Mark 7:13-*thus* invalidating the word of God by your tradition which you have handed down; and you do many things such as that.

1 Cor 3:6-I planted, Apollos watered, but God was causing the growth.

Rom 1:8, 22-23-For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness. 22-23-Professing to be wise, they became fools,²³ and exchanged the glory of the incorruptible God for an image in the form of corruptible man and of birds and four-footed animals and crawling creatures.

"For a Jew to be put out of the synagogue meant that he was ostracized by everyone."

John 7:13-Yet no one was speaking openly of Him for fear of the Jews.

John 3:16-For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life..

John 5:24-Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life.

John 12:42-Nevertheless many even of the rulers believed in Him, but because of the Pharisees they were not confessing *Him*, for fear that they would be put out of the synagogue

2 Tim 2:11-13- It is a trustworthy statement: For if we died with Him, we will also live with Him;¹² If we endure, we will also reign with Him; If we deny Him, He also will deny us;¹³ If we are faithless, He remains faithful, for He cannot deny Himself.

Prov 29:25-The fear of man brings a snare, But he who trusts in the LORD will be exalted.

Matt 10:28- Do not fear those who kill the body but are unable to kill the soul; but rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

2 Tim 1:7-For God has not given us a spirit of timidity, but of power and love and discipline

Rev 21:8-But for the cowardly and unbelieving and abominable and murderers and immoral persons and sorcerers and idolaters and all liars, their part *will be* in the lake that burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.”

Prov 28:1-The wicked flee when no one is pursuing, But the righteous are bold as a lion.

Heb 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, ²¹ equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen
