





- III. Majority (450) manuscripts include the story
- IV. The story is included in some earlier manuscripts
- V. Jerome thought that the story was genuine
- VI. Augustine: some feared that wives would sin with impunity if this story were included







Cross References

John 2:20-The Jews then said, “It took forty-six years to build this temple, and will You raise it up in three days?”

Luke 23:12-Now Herod and Pilate became friends with one another that very day; for before they had been enemies with each other.

Lev 20:10-If *there is* a man who commits adultery with another man’s wife, one who commits adultery with his friend’s wife, the adulterer and the adulteress shall surely be put to death.

Deut 22:22-24-“If a man is found lying with a married woman, then both of them shall die, the man who lay with the woman, and the woman; thus you shall purge the evil from Israel. “If there is a girl who is a virgin engaged to a man, and *another* man finds her in the city and lies with her,²⁴ then you shall bring them both out to the gate of that city and you shall stone them to death; the girl, because she did not cry out in the city, and the man, because he has violated his neighbor’s wife. Thus you shall purge the evil from among you.

John 18:31- So Pilate said to them, “Take Him yourselves, and judge Him according to your law.” The Jews said to him, “We are not permitted to put anyone to death,”³² to fulfill the word of Jesus which He spoke, signifying by what kind of death He was about to die.

Jer 17:13-O LORD, the hope of Israel, All who forsake You will be put to shame.

Those who turn away on earth will be written down, Because they have forsaken the fountain of living water, even the LORD.

Exod 31:18-When He had finished speaking with him upon Mount Sinai, He gave Moses the two tablets of the testimony, tablets of stone, written by the finger of God.

Exod 23:1-You shall not bear a false report; do not join your hand with a wicked man to be a malicious witness.

Lev 24:14- Bring the one who has cursed outside the camp, and let all who heard him lay their hands on his head; then let all the congregation stone him.

Deut 13:9- But you shall surely kill him; your hand shall be first against him to put him to death, and afterwards the hand of all the people.

Deut 17:7- The hand of the witnesses shall be first against him to put him to death, and afterward the hand of all the people. So you shall purge the evil from your midst.

Gal 4:4- But when the fullness of the time came, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law

Matt 5:17- Do not think that I came to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I did not come to abolish but to fulfill

Mark 7:13- *thus* invalidating the word of God by your tradition which you have handed down; and you do many things such as that.

Rev 2:21- I gave her time to repent, and she does not want to repent of her immorality

Gen 6:3- Then the LORD said, “My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, because he also is flesh; nevertheless his days shall be one hundred and twenty years.”

John 2:4- And Jesus *said to her, “Woman, what does that have to do with us? My hour has not yet come.”

John 19:26- When Jesus then saw His mother, and the disciple whom He loved standing nearby, He said to His mother, “Woman, behold, your son!”

John 1:14- And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Rom 8:1- Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus

John 4:27- At this point His disciples came, and they were amazed that He had been speaking with a woman, yet no one said, “What do You seek?” or, “Why do You speak with her?”

Gen 1:26-28- Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; and let them rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over the cattle and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.”²⁷ God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.²⁸ God blessed them; and God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it; and rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over every living thing that moves on the earth.”

Mark 7:13- *thus* invalidating the word of God by your tradition which you have handed down; and you do many things such as that.

Matt 5:17- Do not think that I came to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I did not come to abolish but to fulfill

1 Cor 1:30- But by His doing you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification, and redemption

Matt 22:46- No one was able to answer Him a word, nor did anyone dare from that day on to ask Him another question.

John 1:14- And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

1 Cor 13:1-2- If I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but do not have love, I have become a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. ² If I have *the gift of* prophecy, and know all mysteries and all knowledge; and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing.

1 Tim 1:5- But the goal of our instruction is love from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith.

Ephesians 4:15- but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all *aspects* into Him who is the head, *even* Christ

1 John 2:1- My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous

1 John 1:9- If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Job 9:32-33- “For *He is* not a man as I am that I may answer Him, That we may go to court together. ³³ “There is no umpire between us, Who may lay his hand upon us both.

Heb 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, ²¹ equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
