





Cross References

Micah 5:2-But as for you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, *Too* little to be among the clans of Judah, From you One will go forth for Me to be ruler in Israel. His goings forth are from long ago, From the days of eternity.

Hosea 4:6-My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge.

2 Tim 3:15- and that from childhood you have known the sacred writings which are able to give you the wisdom that leads to salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

Rom 10:17-So faith *comes* from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.

1 Pet 1:23-for you have been born again not of seed which is perishable but imperishable, *that is*, through the living and enduring word of God.

John 1:15-John testified about Him and cried out, saying, "This was He of whom I said, 'He who comes after me has a higher rank than I, for He existed before me."

John 7:37-Now on the last day, the great *day* of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone is thirsty, let him come to Me and drink.

John 12:44-And Jesus cried out and said, "He who believes in Me, does not believe in Me but in Him who sent Me.

John 6:42-They were saying, "Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? How does He now say, 'I have come down out of heaven'?

Matt 7:21-23-"Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven *will enter*. ²² Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?' ²³ And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.'

Dan 9:25-So you are to know and discern *that* from the issuing of a decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince *there* will be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; it will be built again, with plaza and moat, even in times of distress.

Luke 19:42-saying, "If you had known in this day, even you, the things which make for peace! But now they have been hidden from your eyes."

Luke 19:44-and they will level you to the ground and your children within you, and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not recognize the time of your visitation.

John 7:6-So Jesus said to them, "My time is not yet here, but your time is always opportune.

- John 2:4-And Jesus said to her, "Woman, what does that have to do with us? My hour has not yet come."
- John 8:59-Therefore they picked up stones to throw at Him, but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple.
- John 10:18- No one has taken it away from Me, but I lay it down on My own initiative. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. This commandment I received from My Father."
- John 6:15, 26- So Jesus, perceiving that they were intending to come and take Him by force to make Him king, withdrew again to the mountain by Himself alone...Jesus answered them and said, "Truly, truly, I say to you, you seek Me, not because you saw signs, but because you ate of the loaves and were filled.
- Lev 24:16- Moreover, the one who blasphemes the name of the LORD shall surely be put to death; all the congregation shall certainly stone him. The alien as well as the native, when he blasphemes the Name, shall be put to death.
- John 14:6-Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.
- Acts 4:12-And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved.
- 1 Tim 2:5-For there is one God, *and* one mediator also between God and men, *the* man Christ Jesus.
- Col 3:11- *a renewal* in which there is no *distinction between* Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave and freeman, but Christ is all, and in all.

- Jas 1:1- James, a bond-servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, To the twelve tribes who are dispersed abroad: Greetings.
- 1 Pet 1:1- Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, To those who reside as aliens, scattered throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia, who are chosen
- John 2:19-21- Jesus answered them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." ²⁰ The Jews then said, "It took forty-six years to build this temple, and will You raise it up in three days?" ²¹ But He was speaking of the temple of His body.
- John 3:3-4- Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God." Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? He cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born, can he?"
- John 4:13-15- Jesus answered and said to her, "Everyone who drinks of this water will thirst again; ¹⁴ but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him shall never thirst; but the water that I will give him will become in him a well of water springing up to eternal life." The woman said to Him, "Sir, give me this water, so I will not be thirsty nor come all the way here to draw."
- John 6:52- Then the Jews *began* to argue with one another, saying, "How can this man give us *His* flesh to eat?"

Hebrews 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, ²¹ equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen
