





## Cross References

2 Thess 1:7-8- and *to give* relief to you who are afflicted and to us as well when the Lord Jesus will be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels in flaming fire, <sup>8</sup> dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus.

Rev 19:11-16-And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it *is* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and wages war. <sup>12</sup> His eyes *are* a flame of fire, and on His head *are* many diadems; and He has a name written *on Him* which no one knows except Himself. <sup>13</sup> *He is* clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. <sup>14</sup> And the armies which are in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white *and* clean, were following Him on white horses. <sup>15</sup> From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty. <sup>16</sup> And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written, “KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.”

Ps 2:10-12-Now therefore, O kings, show discernment;  
Take warning, O judges of the earth. <sup>11</sup> Worship the LORD with reverence And rejoice with trembling. <sup>12</sup> Do homage to the Son, that He not become angry, and you perish *in* the way,  
For His wrath may soon be kindled. How blessed are all who take refuge in Him!

John 14:6-Jesus \*said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

2 Tim 2:5-For there is one God, *and* one mediator also between God and men, *the* man Christ Jesus

Acts 4:12-And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved.”

John 1:14-And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

John 18:10-11- Simon Peter then, having a sword, drew it and struck the high priest’s slave, and cut off his right ear; and the slave’s name was Malchus. <sup>11</sup> So Jesus said to Peter, “Put the sword into the sheath; the cup which the Father has given Me, shall I not drink it?”

Hebrews 11:25-choosing rather to endure ill-treatment with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin

Matt 5:14-16-“You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden; <sup>15</sup> nor does *anyone* light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. <sup>16</sup> Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

Ephes 5:8-for you were formerly darkness, but now you are Light in the Lord; walk as children of Light

Ephes 5:11-Do not participate in the unfruitful deeds of darkness, but instead even expose them

John 15:20-Remember the word that I said to you, ‘A slave is not greater than his master.’ If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you; if they kept My word, they will keep yours also.

Heb 13:20-21-Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, <sup>21</sup> equip you in every good thing to do His will,

working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
