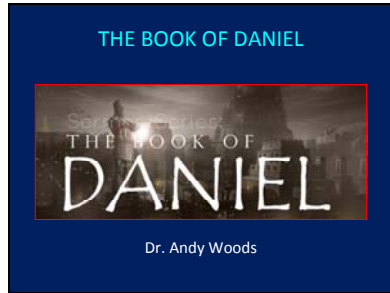

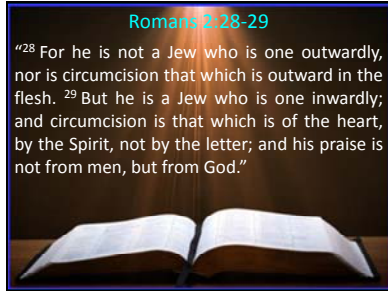

- B. Daniel 7:6, 8:5-8



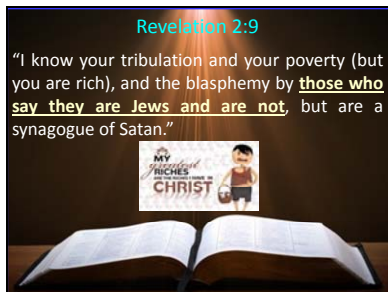

Dan. 9:27-And he will make a firm covenant with **the many** for one week, but in the middle of the week he will put a stop to sacrifice and grain offering; and on the wing of abominations *will come* one who makes desolate, even until a complete destruction, one that is decreed, is poured out on the one who makes desolate.

1 John 3:17- But whoever has the world's goods, and sees his brother in need and closes his heart against him, how does the love of God abide in him?

Jas. 2:15-16- ¹⁵ If a brother or sister is without clothing and in need of daily food, ¹⁶ and one of you says to them, “Go in peace, be warmed and be filled,” and yet you do not give them what is necessary for *their* body, what use is that?

Matt. 5:11-12- Blessed are you when *people* insult you and persecute you, and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of Me. ¹² Rejoice and be glad, for your reward in heaven is great; for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

Matt. 7:13-14- ¹³ “Enter through the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way is broad that leads to destruction, and there are many who enter through it. ¹⁴ For the gate is small and the way is narrow that leads to life, and there are few who find it.

Zech. 13:8-9- “It will come about in all the land,” Declares the LORD, “That two parts in it will be cut off *and* perish; But the

third will be left in it.⁹ “And I will bring the third part through the fire, Refine them as silver is refined, And test them as gold is tested. They will call on My name, And I will answer them; I will say, ‘They are My people,’ And they will say, ‘The LORD is my God.’”

Isaiah 26:20- Come, my people, enter into your rooms And close your doors behind you; Hide for a little while Until **indignation** runs *its* course.

Isa. 14:12-15- “How you have fallen from heaven, O star of the morning, son of the dawn! You have been cut down to the earth, You who have weakened the nations! ¹³ “But you said in your heart, ‘I will ascend to heaven; I will raise my throne above the stars of God, And I will sit on the mount of assembly In the recesses of the north.’¹⁴ ‘I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will make myself like the Most High.’¹⁵ “Nevertheless you will be thrust down to Sheol, To the recesses of the pit.

Rev. 13:4- ⁴ **they worshiped the dragon because he gave his authority to the beast**; and they worshiped the beast, saying, “Who is like the beast, and who is able to wage war with him?”

John 8:44- ⁴⁴ You are of *your* father the devil, and you want to do the desires of your father. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth because there is no truth in him. Whenever he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own *nature*, for he is a liar and the father of lies.

Acts 8:9-11-⁹ Now there was a man named Simon, who formerly was practicing magic in the city and astonishing the people of Samaria, claiming to be someone great; ¹⁰ and they all, from smallest to greatest, were giving attention to him, saying, “This man is what is called the Great Power of God.” ¹¹ And they were giving him attention because he had for a long time astonished them with his magic arts.

John 6:38-³⁸ For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

Dan. 7:23- Thus he said: ‘The fourth beast will be a fourth kingdom on the earth, which will be different from all the *other* kingdoms and will devour the whole earth and tread it down and crush it.

Rev. 13:7- It was also given to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them, and authority over every tribe and people and tongue and nation was given to him.

2 Thess. 2:4- who opposes and exalts himself above every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, displaying himself as being God.

Dan. 7:8- While I was contemplating the horns, behold, another horn, a little one, came up among them, and three of the first horns were pulled out by the roots before it; and behold, this horn possessed eyes like the eyes of a man and **a mouth uttering great boasts**.

Dan. 7:11- Then I kept looking because of **the sound of the boastful words which the horn was speaking**; I kept looking

until the beast was slain, and its body was destroyed and given to the burning fire.

Dan. 7:25- **He will speak out against the Most High** and wear down the saints of the Highest One, and he will intend to make alterations in times and in law; and they will be given into his hand for a time, times, and half a time.

Rev. 13:5-6-⁵ There was given to him **a mouth speaking arrogant words and blasphemies**, and authority to act for forty-two months was given to him. ⁶ And he opened his mouth in blasphemies against God, to blaspheme His name and His tabernacle, *that is*, those who dwell in heaven.

Dan. 7:25- He will speak out against the Most High and wear down the saints of the Highest One, and he will intend to make alterations in times and in law; and they will be given into his hand for **a time, times, and half a time**.

Dan. 11:37 (KJV)- Neither shall he regard the God of his fathers, nor the desire of women, nor regard any god: for he shall magnify himself above all.

1 John 2:18- Children, it is the last hour; and just as you heard that antichrist is coming, even now many antichrists have appeared; from this we know that it is the last hour.

Luke 21:24- and they will fall by the edge of the sword, and will be led captive into all the nations; and Jerusalem will be trampled under foot by the Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled.

Dan. 7:19-20-⁹ “Then I desired to know the exact meaning of the fourth beast, which was different from all the others, exceedingly dreadful, with its teeth of iron and its claws of bronze, *and which* devoured, crushed and trampled down the remainder with its feet,²⁰ *and the meaning* of the ten horns that *were* on its head and the other *horn* which came up, and before which three *of them* fell, namely, that horn which had eyes and a mouth uttering great *boasts* and which was larger in appearance than its associates.

Rev. 13:1- And the dragon stood on the sand of the seashore. Then I saw a beast coming up out of the sea, having ten horns and seven heads, and on his horns *were* ten diadems, and on his heads *were* blasphemous names.

Rev. 17:15- And he *said to me, “The waters which you saw where the harlot sits, are peoples and multitudes and nations and tongues.

Rev. 13:11-¹¹ Then I saw another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb and he spoke as a dragon.

Matt. 2:6- ‘AND YOU, BETHLEHEM, LAND OF JUDAH, ARE BY NO MEANS LEAST AMONG THE LEADERS OF JUDAH; FOR OUT OF YOU SHALL COME FORTH A RULER WHO WILL SHEPHERD MY PEOPLE ISRAEL.’

Luke 1:42-43-⁴² And she cried out with a loud voice and said, “Blessed *are* you among women, and blessed *is* the fruit of your womb! ⁴³ And how has it *happened* to me, that the mother of my Lord would come to me?

1 John 4:3-³ and every spirit that does not confess Jesus is not from God; this is **the spirit of the antichrist, of which you have heard that it is coming, and now it is already in the world.**

2 Thess. 2:7- For **the mystery of lawlessness is already at work**; only he who now restrains *will do so* until he is taken out of the way.

Matt. 6:24- No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth.

Rev. 6:1-2- Then I saw when the Lamb broke one of the seven seals, and I heard one of the four living creatures saying as with a voice of thunder, “Come.”² I looked, and behold, a white horse, and he who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer.
