Titus 1:2-in the hope of eternal life, which <u>God, who cannot</u> <u>lie</u>, promised long ages ago.

Heb. 6:18-so that by two unchangeable things in which <u>it is</u> <u>impossible for God to lie</u>, we who have taken refuge would have strong encouragement to take hold of the hope set before us.

Rev. 16:17-Then the seventh *angel* poured out his bowl upon the air, and a loud voice came out of the temple from the throne, saying, "It is done."

Rev. 6:9-11-9 When the Lamb broke the fifth seal, I saw underneath the altar the souls of those who had been slain because of the word of God, and because of the testimony which they had maintained; ¹⁰ and they cried out with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, will You refrain from judging and avenging our blood on those who dwell on the earth?" ¹¹ And there was given to each of them a white robe; and they were told that they should rest for a little while longer, until the number of their fellow servants and their brethren who were to be killed even as they had been, would be completed also.

<u>10</u>

Job 23:12- I have not departed from the command of His lips; I have treasured the words of His mouth more than my necessary food.

Deut. 8:3- He humbled you and let you be hungry, and fed you with manna which you did not know, nor did your fathers know, that He might make you understand that <u>man does not live by bread alone</u>, but man lives by everything that proceeds out of the mouth of the LORD.

Matt. 4:4- But He answered and said, "It is written, 'MAN SHALL NOT LIVE ON BREAD ALONE, BUT ON EVERY WORD THAT PROCEEDS OUT OF THE MOUTH OF GOD."

1 Pet. 2:2- like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation.

Ezek. 2:8–3:3- ⁸"Now you, son of man, listen to what I am speaking to you; do not be rebellious like that rebellious house. Open your mouth and eat what I am giving you." ⁹ Then I looked, and behold, a hand was extended to me; and lo, a scroll *was* in it. ¹⁰ When He spread it out before me, it was written on the front and back, and written on it were lamentations, mourning and woe. ¹Then He said to me, "Son of man, eat what you find; eat this scroll, and go, speak to the house of Israel." ² So I opened my mouth, and He fed me this scroll. ³ He said to me, "Son of man, feed your stomach and fill your body with this scroll which I am giving you." Then I ate it, and it was sweet as honey in my mouth.

Ezek. 3:4-11-⁴ Then He said to me, "Son of man, go to the house of Israel and <u>speak</u> with My words to them. ⁵ For you are not being sent to a people of unintelligible speech or difficult language, *but* to the house of Israel, ⁶ nor to many peoples of unintelligible speech or difficult language, whose words you cannot understand. But I have sent you to them who should listen to you; ⁷ yet the house of Israel will not be willing to listen to you, since they are not willing to listen to Me. Surely the whole house of Israel is stubborn and obstinate. ⁸ Behold, I have made your face as hard as their faces and your forehead as hard as their foreheads. ⁹ Like emery harder than flint I have made

your forehead. Do not be afraid of them or be dismayed before them, though they are a rebellious house." Moreover, He said to me, "Son of man, take into your heart all My words which I will speak to you and listen closely. ¹¹ Go to the exiles, to the sons of your people, and speak to them and tell them, whether they listen or not, 'Thus says the Lord GOD."

2 Tim. 2:15-Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth.

Gen. 1:5-God called the light day, and the darkness He called night. And there was evening and there was morning, one day.

Rev. 11:15- Then the seventh angel sounded; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdom of the world has become *the kingdom* of our Lord and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever."
