Ezra 1:6-And all of those around them encouraged them with articles of <u>silver</u>, <u>with gold</u>, with equipment, cattle, and with valuables, aside from everything that was given as a <u>voluntary</u> <u>offering</u>.

But these seven will be glad when they see the plumb line in the hand of Zerubbabel—these are the eyes of the LORD which range to and fro throughout the earth."

Isa. 56:6-7-"⁶ Also the foreigners who join themselves to the LORD, To minister to Him, and to love the name of the LORD, To be His servants, every one who keeps from profaning the sabbath And holds fast My covenant; ⁷ Even those I will bring to

My holy mountain And make them joyful in My house of prayer. Their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be acceptable on My altar; For <u>My house</u> will be called a house of prayer for all the peoples."

Isa. 65:20- No longer will there be in it an infant who lives but a few days, Or an old man who does not live out his days; For the youth will <u>die</u> at the age of one hundred And the one who does not reach the age of one hundred Will be *thought* accursed.

Acts 21:26- Then Paul took the men, and the next day, purifying himself along with them, went into the temple giving notice of
