Rev. 2:17-"He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith to the churches. To him that overcometh, to him will I give of the hidden manna, and I will give him a white stone, and upon the stone a **new name written**, which no one knoweth but he that receiveth it."

2 Cor. 5:17-"Wherefore if any man is in Christ, he is a <u>new</u> <u>creature</u>: the old things are passed away; behold, they are become new."

Isa. 14:13-But <u>you said in your heart</u>, 'I will ascend to heaven; I will raise my throne above the stars of God, And I will sit on the mount of assembly In the recesses of the north.

Ezek. 25:3-4-³ and say to the sons of Ammon, 'Hear the word of the Lord GoD! This is what the Lord GoD says: "Because you said, 'Aha!' against My sanctuary when it was profaned, and against the land of Israel when it was made desolate, and against the house of Judah when they went into exile, ⁴ therefore, behold, I am going to give you to the people of the east as a possession, and they will set up their encampments among you and make their dwellings among you; they will eat your fruit and drink your milk.

Ps. 139:4-Even before there is a word on my tongue, Behold, LORD, You know it all.

Matt. 12:24-25-²⁴ But when the Pharisees heard *this*, they said, "This man casts out demons only by Beelzebul the ruler of the

demons." ²⁵ And <u>knowing their thoughts</u>, *Jesus* said to them, "Every kingdom divided against itself is laid waste; and no city or house divided against itself will stand.

Gen. 18:14-**Is anything too difficult for the LORD**? At the appointed time I will return to you, at this time next year, and Sarah will have a son.

Ps. 2:1-4-"He that sitteth in the heavens will **laugh**: The Lord will have them in derision."

John 3:16-For <u>God so loved the world</u>, that He gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him will not perish, but have eternal life.

1 John 4:8-The one who does not love does not know God, because **God is love**.

Gen. 25:12-18-12 Now these are the records of the generations of Ishmael, Abraham's son, whom Hagar the Egyptian, Sarah's slave woman, bore to Abraham; 13 and these are the names of the sons of Ishmael, by their names, in the order of their birth: Nebaioth, the firstborn of Ishmael, Kedar, Adbeel, Mibsam, 14 Mishma, Dumah, Massa, 15 Hadad, Tema, Jetur, Naphish, and Kedemah. 16 These are the sons of Ishmael and these are their names, by their villages, and by their camps; twelve princes according to their tribes. 17 These are the years of the life of Ishmael, 137 years; and he breathed his last and died, and was gathered to his people. 18 They settled

from Havilah to Shur which is east of Egypt going toward Assyria; he settled in defiance of all his relatives.

Gen. 35:13-Then **God went up from him** at the place where He had spoken with him.

Ezek. 11:24-And the Spirit lifted me up and brought me in a vision by the Spirit of God to Chaldea, to the exiles. Then <u>the</u> vision that I had seen left me.

Heb. 1:1-2-God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways, ² in these last days has spoken to us in *His* Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom He also made the world.

Jude 3-Beloved, while I was making every effort to write you about our common salvation, I felt the necessity to write to you appealing that you contend earnestly for **the faith that was once** for all *time* handed down to the saints.

Conclusion

Gen. 17:11-And you shall be circumcised in the flesh of your foreskin, and it shall be the **sign of the covenant** between Me and you.

Rom. 4:9-12-9 Is this blessing then on the circumcised, or on the uncircumcised also? For we say, "FAITH WAS CREDITED TO ABRAHAM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS." 10 How then was it credited? While he was circumcised, or uncircumcised? Not while circumcised, but while uncircumcised; 11 and he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the faith

which he had while uncircumcised, so that he might be the father of all who believe without being circumcised, that righteousness might be credited to them, ¹² and the father of circumcision to those who not only are of the circumcision, but who also follow in the steps of the faith of our father Abraham which he had while uncircumcised.

Gal. 5:6-For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision means anything, but faith working through love.

1 Cor. 7:19-Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but *what matters is* the keeping of the commandments of God.

Rom. 2:28-29-²⁸ For he is not a Jew who is one outwardly, nor is circumcision that which is outward in the flesh. ²⁹ But he is a Jew who is one inwardly; and circumcision is of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the letter; and his praise is not from people, but from God.

Gal. 6:12-15-¹² All who want to make a good showing in the flesh try to compel you to be circumcised, simply so that they will not be persecuted for the cross of Christ. ¹³ For those who are circumcised do not even keep the Law themselves, but they want to have you circumcised so that they may boast in your flesh. ¹⁴ But far be it from me to boast, except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. ¹⁵ For neither is circumcision anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation.

Col. 2:11-13-11 and in Him you were also circumcised with a circumcision performed without hands, in the removal of the

body of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ, ¹² having been buried with Him in baptism, in which you were also raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead. ¹³ And when you were dead in your wrongdoings and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our wrongdoings.

Num. 6:24-26-²⁴ The LORD bless you, and keep you; ²⁵ The LORD cause His face to shine on you, And be gracious to you; ²⁶ The LORD lift up His face to you, And give you peace.
