Jonah 1:3-But Jonah got up to flee to <u>Tarshish</u> from the presence of the LORD. So he went down to Joppa, found a ship that was going to Tarshish, paid the fare, and boarded it to go with them to Tarshish away from the presence of the LORD.

<u>16</u>

- 2 Tim 3:1-But realize this, that in the <u>last days</u> difficult times will come.
- Isa 2:2-Now it will come about that In the <u>last days</u> The mountain of the house of the LORD Will be established as the chief of the mountains, And will be raised above the hills; And all the nations will stream to it.
- Jer 23:20-The anger of the LORD will not turn back Until He has performed and carried out the purposes of His heart; In the <u>last</u> <u>days</u> you will clearly understand it.
- Jer 30:24-The fierce anger of the LORD will not turn back Until He has performed and until He has accomplished The intent of His heart; In the <u>latter days</u> you will understand this.
