Gen. 18:2-When he raised his eyes and looked, behold, **<u>three men</u>** were standing opposite him; and when he saw *them*, he ran from the tent door to meet them and bowed down to the ground

Gen. 18:22-Then the <u>men turned away from there and went</u> <u>toward Sodom</u>, while Abraham was still standing before the LORD.

Gen. 13:12-Abram settled in the land of Canaan, while <u>Lot</u> settled in the cities of the vicinity of the *Jordan*, and <u>moved</u> <u>his tents as far as Sodom</u>.

Gen. 14:12-They also took <u>Lot</u>, Abram's nephew, and his possessions and departed, for he was <u>living in Sodom</u>.

Ruth 4:1-2-¹ Now Boaz went up to the gate and sat down there, and behold, the redeemer of whom Boaz spoke was passing by, so he said, "Come over here, friend, sit down here." And he came over and sat down. ² Then he took ten men of the elders of the city and said, "Sit down here." So they sat down.

1 John 2:15-17-¹⁵ Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. ¹⁶ For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world. ¹⁷ The world is passing away and *also* its lusts; but the one who does the will of God continues *to live* forever.

2 Tim. 4:10-for **Demas, having loved this present world, has <u>deserted me</u> and gone to Thessalonica; Crescens** *has gone* **to Galatia, Titus to Dalmatia.**

Rom. 12:13-contributing to the needs of the saints, practicing **hospitality**.

Heb. 13:2-Do not neglect hospitality to strangers, for by this some have entertained <u>angels</u> without knowing it.

Gen. 18:8-He took curds and milk and the calf which he had prepared, and set *it* before them; and he was standing by them under the tree as <u>they ate</u>.

Jude 6-7-⁶ And angels who did not keep their own domain, but abandoned their proper abode, He has kept in eternal bonds under darkness for the judgment of the great day, ⁷ just as <u>Sodom and</u> <u>Gomorrah and the cities around them, since they in the same</u> <u>way as these indulged in gross immorality and went</u> <u>after strange flesh</u>, are exhibited as an example in undergoing the punishment of eternal fire.

Ezek. 16:49-Behold, this was the guilt of your sister <u>Sodom</u>: she and her daughters had arrogance, plenty of food, and carefree ease, but <u>she did not help the poor and needy</u>.

Gen. 18:20-And the LORD said, "The outcry of Sodom and Gomorrah is indeed great, and their <u>sin is exceedingly grave</u>.

1 Cor. 5:1-It is actually reported that there is immorality among you, and <u>immorality of such a kind as does not exist even</u> <u>among the Gentiles</u>, that someone has his father's wife.

2 Tim. 3:12-Indeed, all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will be persecuted.

Deut. 28:28-The LORD will smite you with madness and with **blindness** and with bewilderment of heart.
