Zechariah 14:10 (RSBEE:NASB1995U): 14:10 <u>Geba</u>. Six mi. (9.6 km) NE of Jerusalem. <u>Rimmon</u>. 35 mi. (56 km) SW of Jerusalem (see Isa. 2:2). <u>Benjamin's Gate</u> was in the northern wall of Jerusalem; the <u>First Gate</u> at the NE corner; the <u>Corner</u> <u>Gate</u> at the NW corner; the <u>Tower of Hananel</u> at the northern corner; the <u>king's wine presses</u> at the S end (Neh. 3:15).

## <u>11</u>
