Acts 18:1-After these things he left Athens and went to **Corinth**.

Acts 18:5-But when <u>Silas and Timothy</u> came down from Macedonia, <u>Paul</u> began devoting himself completely to the word, solemnly testifying to the Jews that Jesus was the Christ.

Romans 5:1-Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have **peace** with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Romans 5:10-For if while we were <u>enemies</u> we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

John 14:26–27-But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you." **Peace** I leave with you; My **peace** I give to you; not as the **world** gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful.

Philippians 4:6–7-Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the **peace** of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Mark 4:35-41-<sup>35</sup> On that day, when evening came, He said to them, "Let us go over to the other side." <sup>36</sup> Leaving the crowd, they took Him along with them in the boat, just as He was; and other boats were with Him. <sup>37</sup> And there arose a fierce gale of wind, and the waves were breaking over the boat so much that the

boat was already filling up. <sup>38</sup> Jesus Himself was in the stern, asleep on the cushion; and they woke Him and said to Him, "Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?" <sup>39</sup> And He got up and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, "Hush, be still." And the wind died down and it became perfectly calm. <sup>40</sup> And He said to them, "Why are you afraid? Do you still have no faith?" <sup>41</sup> They became very much afraid and said to one another, "Who then is this, that even the wind and the sea obey Him?"

Gal. 2:20-I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but <u>Christ lives in me</u>; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

James 5:16-Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. <u>The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much</u>.

1 John 5:14-This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.

Rom. 12:2-And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your **mind**, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

Philip. 4:8-Finally, brethren, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is of good repute, if there is any excellence and if anything worthy of praise, **dwell** on these things.

Josh. 1:8-This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall **meditate on it day and night**, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success.

Matthew 12:46–50-While He was still speaking to the crowds, behold, His mother and brothers were standing outside, seeking to speak to Him. Someone said to Him, "Behold, Your mother

and Your brothers are standing outside seeking to speak to You." But Jesus answered the one who was telling Him and said, "Who is My mother and who are My brothers?" And stretching out His hand toward His disciples, He said, "Behold My mother and My brothers!" For whoever does the will of My Father who is in heaven, he is My brother and sister and mother."

Revelation 22:17-The Spirit and the bride say, "Come." And let the one who hears say, "Come." And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who wishes take the water of life without cost.

<u>5</u>

1 Corinthians 2:1–6-And when I came to you, brethren, I did not come with <u>superiority of speech or of wisdom</u>, proclaiming to you the testimony of God. For I determined to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ, and Him crucified. I was with you in weakness and in fear and in much trembling, and my message and my preaching were not in <u>persuasive words</u> of wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of <u>power</u>, so that your faith would not rest on the <u>wisdom of men</u>, but on the <u>power of God</u>. Yet we do speak wisdom among those who are mature; a wisdom, however, not of this age nor of the rulers of this age, who are passing away.

John 16:7–11-But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you." And He, when He comes, will **convict** the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment; concerning sin, because they do not believe in Me; and concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father and you no

longer see Me; and concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world has been judged.

1 Thessalonians 2:9-For you recall, brethren, our labor and hardship, how working night, and day so as not to be a burden to any of you, we proclaimed to you the gospel of God.

Acts 18:3-and because he was of the same trade, he stayed with them and they were working, for by trade they were **tentmakers**.

1 Corinthians 11:1-Be **imitators** of me, just as I also am of Christ.

Ephesians 5:1-Therefore be <u>imitators</u> of God, as beloved children

1 Timothy 3:15-but in case I am delayed, I write so that you will know how one ought to conduct himself in the household of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and support of **the truth**.
