1 Corinthians 2:1–6-And when I came to you, brethren, I did not come with <u>superiority of speech or of wisdom</u>, proclaiming to you the testimony of God. For I determined to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ, and Him crucified. I was with you in weakness and in fear and in much trembling, and my message and my preaching were not in <u>persuasive words</u> of wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of <u>power</u>, so that your faith would not rest on the <u>wisdom of men, but on the power of God</u>. Yet we do speak wisdom among those who are mature; a wisdom, however, not of this age nor of the rulers of this age, who are passing away.

John 16:7–11-But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you." And He, when He comes,

will **<u>convict</u>** the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment; concerning sin, because they do not believe in Me; and concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father and you no longer see Me; and concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world has been judged.

1 Thessalonians 2:9-For you recall, brethren, our labor and hardship, how working night, and day so as not to be a burden to any of you, we proclaimed to you the gospel of God.

Acts 18:3-and because he was of the same trade, he stayed with them and they were working, for by trade they were <u>tentmakers</u>.

Isaiah 46:1–4-Bel has bowed down, Nebo stoops over; Their images are consigned to the beasts and the cattle. <u>The things that</u> <u>you carry are burdensome</u>, A load for the weary beast.
