Rom. 10:17- So <u>faith</u> comes from <u>hearing</u>, and hearing by the <u>word</u> of Christ.

2 Tim. 3:15-¹⁵ and that from childhood you have known the **sacred writings** which are able to give you the **wisdom that leads to salvation** through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

Jas. 1:18-In the exercise of His will He gave us **birth by the word** of truth, so that we would be a kind of first fruits among His creatures.

1 Pet. 1:23-for you have been **born again** not of seed which is perishable, but imperishable, *that is*, through the living and enduring **word of God**.

Luke 16:27-31-²⁷ And he said, 'Then I beg you, father, that you send him to my father's house—²⁸ for I have five brothers—in order that he may warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.' ²⁹ But Abraham said, 'They have Moses and the Prophets; let them hear them.' ³⁰ But he said, 'No, father Abraham, but if someone goes to them from the dead, they will repent!' ³¹ But he said to him, 'If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be persuaded even if someone rises from the dead."'

Matt. 23:34-35-³⁴ "Therefore, behold, I am sending you prophets and wise men and scribes; some of them you will kill and crucify, and some of them you will flog in your synagogues, and persecute from city to city, ³⁵ so that upon you will fall *the guilt of* all the righteous blood shed on earth, <u>from the blood of righteous Abel</u> to the blood of <u>Zechariah</u>, the son of Berechiah, whom you murdered between the temple and the altar.

2 Chron. 36:16-but they continually mocked the messengers of God, despised His words and scoffed at His **prophets**, until the wrath of the Lord arose against His people, until there was no remedy.

Rom. 5:10-For if while we were **enemies** we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

Rom. 8:7-8-7 because the mind set on the flesh is hostile toward God; for it does not subject itself to the law of God, for it is not even able *to do so*, 8 and those who are in the flesh **cannot please God**.

1 Pet. 4:12-Beloved, do not be <u>surprised</u> at the fiery ordeal among you, which comes upon you for your testing, as though *something* <u>strange</u> were happening to you.
