Gen. 20:12-Besides, she actually is my sister, the daughter of my father, but not the daughter of my mother, and she became my wife.

Exod. 20:16-You shall not bear <u>false witness</u> against your neighbor.

John 14:6-Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and <u>the truth</u>, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me

1 Tim. 3:15-but in case I am delayed, I write so that you will know how one ought to conduct himself in the household of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and support of the **truth**.

Eph. 4:25-Therefore, laying aside falsehood, SPEAK <u>TRUTH</u> EACH ONE *of you* WITH HIS NEIGHBOR, for we are members of one another.

Josh. 1:6-Be **strong and courageous**, for you shall give this people possession of the land which I swore to their fathers to give them.

Prov. 28:1-The <u>wicked flee</u> when no one is pursuing, But the <u>righteous are bold</u> as a lion.

2 Tim. 1:7-For God has not given us <u>a spirit of timidity</u>, but of power and love and discipline.

Matt. 25:25-And I was <u>afraid</u>, and went away and hid your talent in the ground. See, you have what is yours.

Luke 12:48-but the one who did not know *it*, and committed deeds worthy of a flogging, will receive but few. From everyone who has been given much, much will be required; and to whom they entrusted much, of him they will ask all the more.

Dan. 4:18-22-

<sup>18</sup>O king, the Most High God granted sovereignty, grandeur, glory and majesty to Nebuchadnezzar your father. <sup>19</sup> Because of the grandeur which He bestowed on him, all the peoples, nations and men of every language feared and trembled before him; whomever he wished he killed and whomever he wished he spared alive; and whomever he wished he elevated and whomever he wished he humbled. <sup>20</sup> But when his heart was lifted up and his spirit became so proud that he behaved arrogantly, he was deposed from his royal throne and his glory was taken away from him. 21 He was also driven away from mankind, and his heart was made like that of beasts, and his dwelling place was with the wild donkeys. He was given grass to eat like cattle, and his body was drenched with the dew of heaven until he recognized that the Most High God is ruler over the realm of mankind and that He sets over it whomever He wishes. 22 Yet you, his son, Belshazzar, have not humbled your heart, even though you knew all this.

Gen. 12:11-It came about when he came near to Egypt, that he said to Sarai his wife, "See now, I know that you are **a beautiful woman**.

Prov. 31:30-Charm is deceitful and beauty is vain, *But* a woman who fears the LORD, she shall be praised.

1 Pet. 3:3-6-<sup>3</sup> Your <u>adornment</u> must not be *merely* external—braiding the hair, and wearing gold jewelry, or putting on dresses; <sup>4</sup> but *let it be* the <u>hidden person of the heart, with the imperishable quality of a gentle and quiet spirit</u>, which is precious in the sight of God. <sup>5</sup> For in this way in former times the holy women also, who hoped in God, used to adorn themselves, being submissive to their own husbands; <sup>6</sup> just as <u>Sarah</u> obeyed Abraham, calling him lord, and you have become her children if you do what is right without being frightened by any fear.

Gal. 6:7-8-<sup>7</sup>Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; **for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap**. <sup>8</sup>For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.

Num. 32:23-But if you will not do so, behold, you have sinned against the LORD, and be sure **your sin will find you out**.

Prov. 29:25-The <u>fear of man brings a snare</u>, but he who trusts in the LORD will be exalted.

Matt. 10:28-31-<sup>28</sup> Do not fear those who kill the body but are unable to kill the soul; but rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. <sup>29</sup> Are not two sparrows sold for a cent? And *yet* not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your father. <sup>30</sup> But the very hairs of your head are all
