Heb. 1:1-2-¹ God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways, ² in these last days has spoken to us <u>in His Son</u>, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world.

Gen. 12:2-And I will make you a great nation, And <u>I will bless</u> <u>you</u>, and make your name great; And so you shall be a blessing

Mal. 3:6- For <u>I, the Lord, do not change</u>; therefore you, O sons of Jacob, are not consumed.

Eph. 1:13-14-¹³ In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed in Him with <u>the Holy Spirit</u> of promise,¹⁴ who is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of *God's own* possession, to the praise of His glory.

Eph. 4:30-Do not grieve the <u>Holy Spirit</u> of God, by whom you were <u>sealed</u> for the day of redemption.
